Organized April 18, 1924

Our records show the Rev. Anson Williams serving the church in 1945, followed in 1946 and 1947 by the Rev. Carl Hall.

From 1948 until 1951, the Rev. Morten Sorensen served as pastor.

Captain William Berry, master of the Sea Coast Mission vessel, SUNBEAM, acted as pastor during the winters of 1953 through 1956. There is also mention of the Rev. Will Duff serving in 1954.

The Rev. Perry L. Smith, D.D., was the summer minister in 1955.

The Rev. Wesley Osborne and the Rev. John Barclay shared the duties of the summer schedule beginning in 1956.

The Rev. Verne Smith began his ministry in September of 1956 and remained until the latter part of 1957.

Miss Edith Drury served in 1959, 1960 and 1961.

The Rev. I Cecilia Piper of Addison gave many years of service throughout the 1960's and 1970's until her retirement in September of 1977.

Many of the supply pastors, especially Mr. Osborne and Mr. Barclay, lived at the Sea Coast Mission camp called "Tugwassa" on Jones' Pond in West Gouldsboro.
