I send you 5 bbls plaster and want you to arrange to save me what chum vou make. It should be put in a pit or hollow.spread out say three inches deep and a few shovels full of plaster sprinkled over and say an inch of dry muck. Brown said there was some muck which Mr. Hammond would get out for me. It should be well dried and pulverized so as to absorb the water from the lobsters, and as little used as possible, as I do not want to increase the bulk any more than possible. Some posts should be put up and old boards put on them so as to shed rain.as it will speil the chum to have water running through it. Now I want this done as cheaply as possible and leave it to you to manage. trusting that a good fertilizer can by this means be obtained cheaply.
