



The F.P. Noyes General Store in West Gouldsboro as it looked about 1914. F.P. Noyes, a direct descendant of Revolutionary War hero Daniel Sullivan, operated the store at the turn of the century when it was one of the

schooners plying the Maine coast. His son, Chandler, took over in 1928 and operated the store for years. Today the same building houses the Maine Kiln Works.
