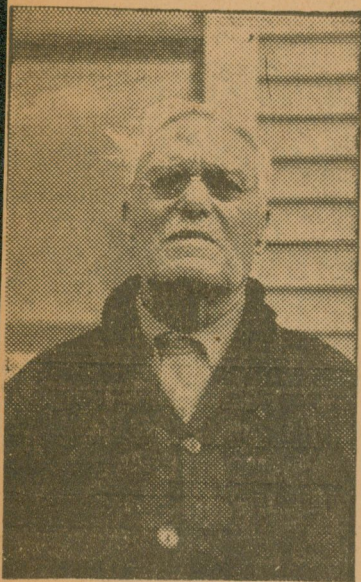


Prospect Harbor's
