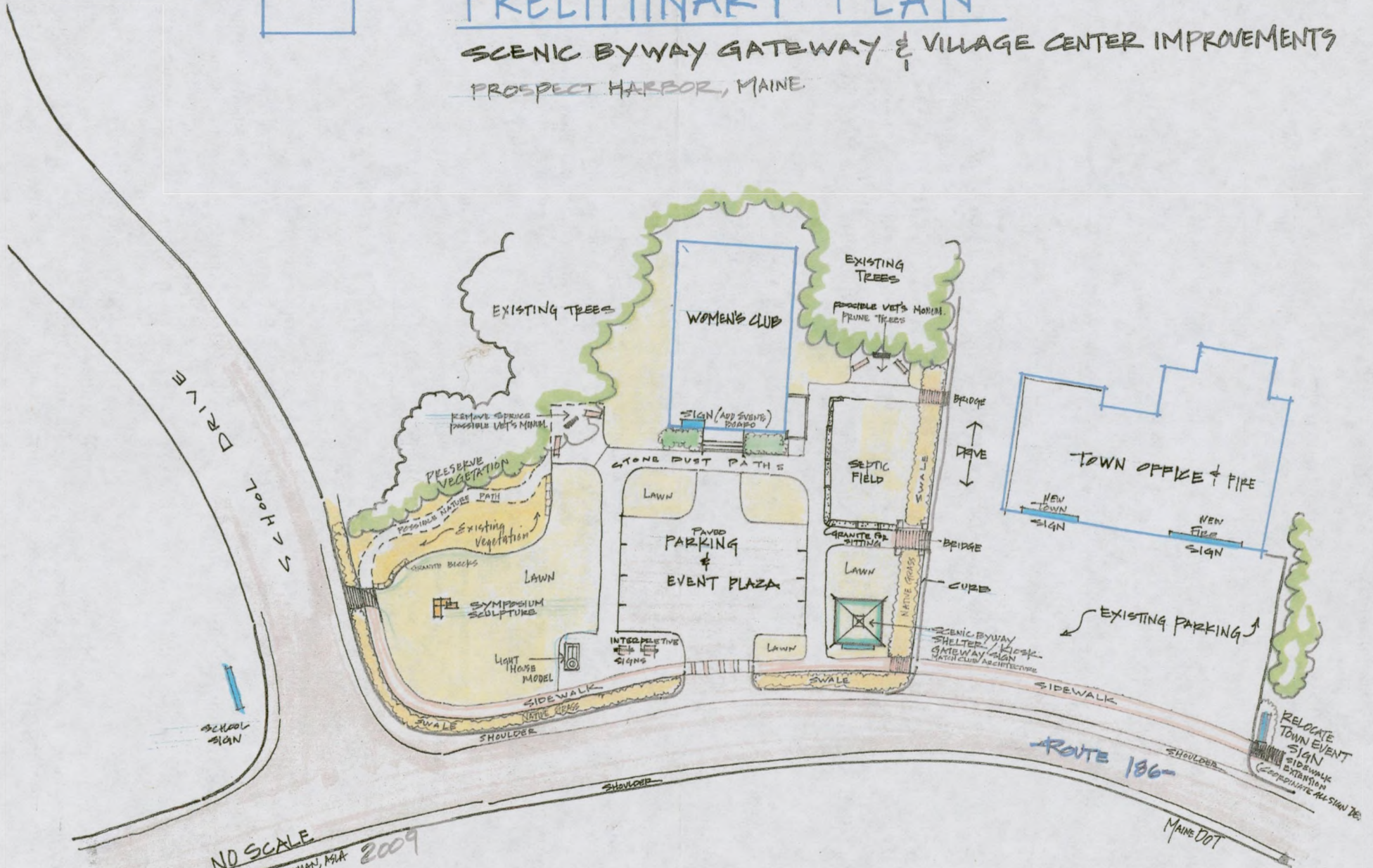

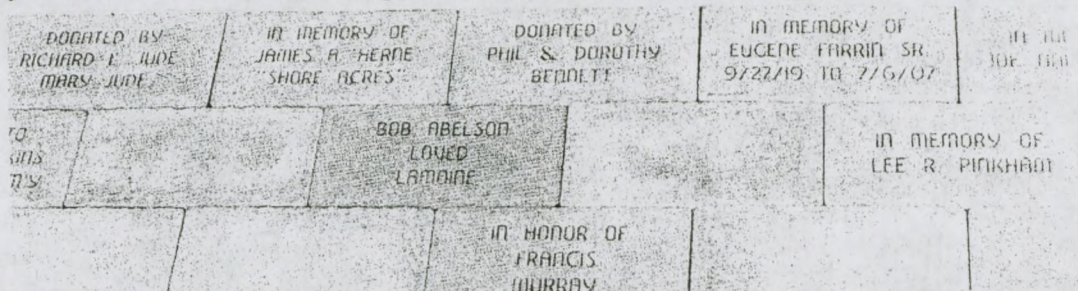

SCHOODIC SCENIC BYWAY PLAN AND INFORMATION

The plan on the flip side of this document is a preliminary draft that was prepared by MDOT Senior Architect, Larry Johannesman. The project hopes to accomplish a number of improvements to the area. The following list of objectives represents the current thinking and ideas of how to develop the gateway facility and improve the village center. More design, engineering work and public comment are needed.

- Create a significant element to denote the byway gateway and locate interpretive panels to allow travelers to learn about the history of the community.
- Locate a brochure dispenser with an informational kiosk that will provide visitors with information about scenic, cultural, recreational, dining and lodging opportunities.
- Improve and upgrade vehicle access and parking to serve byway travelers and residents.
- Improve outdoor spaces for byway visitors and town citizens to enjoy.
- Provide more efficient use of property through solving site drainage issues.
- Improve and increase spaces for Community Center art and outdoor events.
- Provide a convenient and safe location to catch the free Island Explorer shuttle bus.
- Design and engineer sidewalks along Main Street to connect public areas along the street.
- Make a pedestrian connection between the town office, community building and new school driveway.
- Create a recreational opportunity and/or visually pleasing green space.
- Incorporate native plants, shade trees and flowers fitting to the sites of coastal Maine.

One very important piece to be incorporated into the byway design will be the creation of a space for a veteran's monument and related granite benches with concrete foundations. Although byway funds will be available to create landscaping for the memorial area the monument itself will be funded by fund raising and donations. We will be selling engraved bricks that will be used as a foundation around the monument. The cost of each brick is \$50 and can be dedicated in honor of any veteran. Below is an example of how the bricks will be engraved. There is also a sample brick in the town office.
