## Fall And Winter Suppers In So. Gouldsboro Church

The November Supper, the second in the series of six, is being sponsored by the Women's Circle of the Bunker Memorial Church, Thursday, Nov. 11th. Mrs. Frank Gerrish is the Chairman of the sponsoring group.

Following the supper, Mr. Horace Quick, Professor of Game Management at the University of Maine, will show pictures and discuss the work of the University in studying and improving hunting in the State. The supper will be served from 5:00 to 6:30 P. M. Professor Quick will start showing the pictures at 7 P.M.

The December 9 supper will be sponsored by the Church Sunday School, Mrs. Adelbert Hooper, Chairman. After the supper Mr. Lewis Bissell, Forestry Specialist from the University of Maine Extension Service will show movies and discuss the forest and woodland management of Maine.

The January 13th supper will be sponsored by the Factory Canning Folks, Mrs. Everett Potter, Chairman. The supper will be followed by the showing of pictures on the various fishing activities in Maine and the work of the Department in Maine Fisheries Research and Management by Mr. Robert C. Dow, Director of Maine Research Department of Sea and Shore Fisheries and Game.

The February 10th supper will be sponsored by the Business and Professional Men, Frank Gerrish, Chairman. It will be followed by Keith A. Havey, Regional Fishery Biologist of the Department of Inland Fisheries and Game, who will show pictures on the stream fishing research and management of the Department.

The March 10th supper will be sponsored by the School Improvement Club of South Gouldsboro, George Duke, Chairman. After the supper, Carl A. Rogers, Hancock County Agent for the University of Maine Extension Service, will show pictures on scenery and agricultural enterprises in Hancock County. These pictures will include several of the people who are well known in the Gouldsboro area.

The Church officers have organized the contract for the installation of the heating plant by the Bangor Branch of Sears Roebuck and Company. It is expected that the plant will be in operation some time during the month of November.
