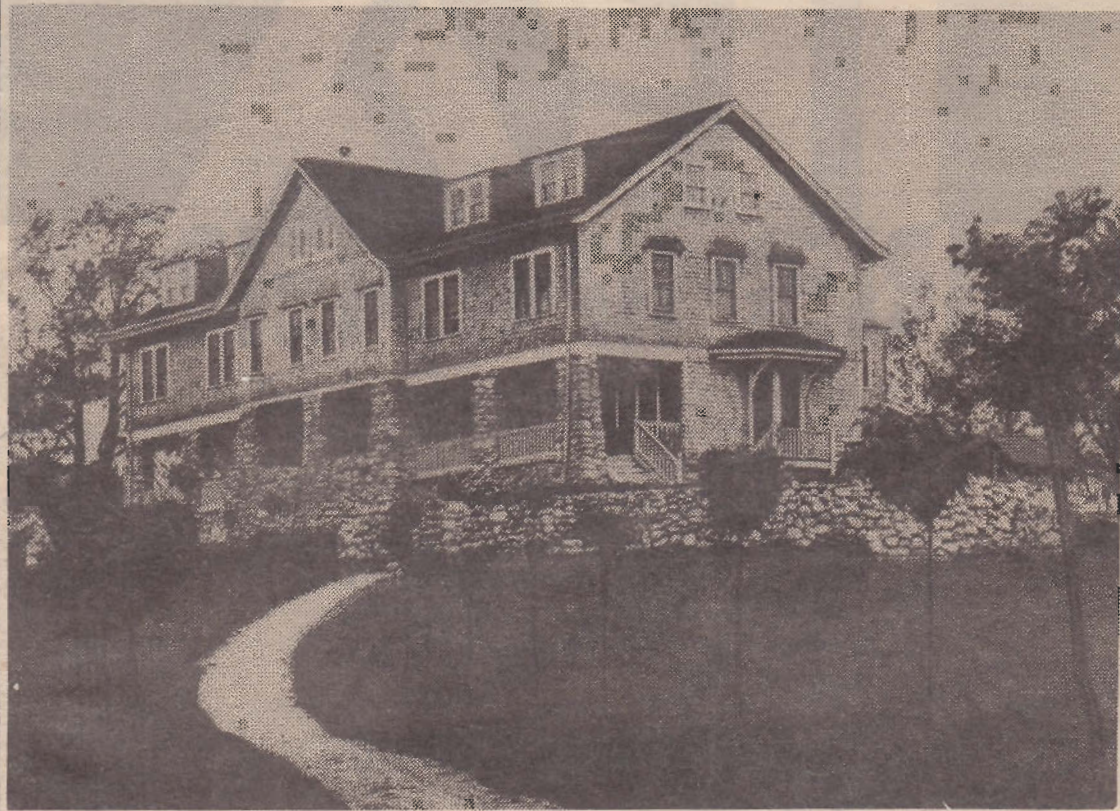


RECOLLECTIONS

THIS IS THE MAHWAH INN OR MILLER INN, a boarding house, as shown on a postcard dated Sept. 29, 1910. Completed in the spring of 1904, the Inn was managed by Mrs. Ezra W. Miller, after her husband died in 1905, until it was destroyed by fire in May 1927. It was located 1000 yards north (now the Snow Drive area) of the site of "Oweno", the Col. Ezra Miller mansion also destroyed by fire in 1899. The Miller property of 140 acres became the Cragmere section of Mahwah. Postcard from Chester Smeltzer collection.
