FISHER LINEAGE

After spending considerable time doing extensive research on our Fisher family line, the line is still incomplete. Information on the earlier generations could not be found even with the help of a professional genealogist.

It is believed that the Fishers originally came to this country from the Palatinate, Germany. Just when our emigrant arrived in America, we don't know, but there were families named Fisher in the state of New Jersey in the early 1700's. We found information on Fishers living in Hunterdon County, Somerset County, Gloucester County as well as Bergen County, New Jersey.

There was a Peter Fisher who died between his will date of 24 April 1769 and probate date of 6 May 1769. He left a widow, Catharine Fisher, and they lived in the Saddle River Precinct, Bergen County. Also, a Catrin Fisher died 1 April 1787 and was buried from the Lutheran Church of Ramapo, New Jersey. A Michel Fisher was baptised 30 November 1760 and he was the son of Michel Fisher. An Elizabeth Fisher was born 8 June 1778, and she was the daughter of a Lodewig and Polly Fisher. Another Polly Fisher was born 8 July 1776 to a Lewis Fisher.

Although all of these mentioned Fishers resided in Bergen County, New Jersey, their relationship to our particular line is unproven and unknown.

Hence, we begin with our own proven ancestors, David Fisher and his wife, Elizabeth:

IN THE NAME OF JOD, AMEN.

I, Mary S. Fisher, of the Borough of Ramsey, in the County of Bergen and State of New Jersey, being of sound mind, memory and understanding do make and publish this my last will and testament in manner following, that is to say:

First: I direct my executors hereinafter named to pay all my just debts and funeral expenses, as soon as may be reasonable after my decease.

Second: I give, devise and bequeath unto my beloved husband David Fisher the income, rents, issues and profits of all my estate, both real and personal, excepting my automobile, for and during the term of his natural life.

Third: I give and bequeath my automobile to my son David Fisher.

Fourth: At the death of my said husband, David Fisher, I give, devise and bequeath all my estate, both real and personal unto my children, Kate Goetschius, wife of George E. Goetschius, William Fisher, Mamie May, wife of Michael May, Lizzie VanBlarcom, widow, Fannie Bartholf, wife of Gilbert A. Bartholf, and Ratie VanBlarcom, wife of Lewis E. VanBlarcom, share and share alike, however, I direct that the share of my son William Fisher shall be held in trust by my executors, who shall pay to him as long as he shall live the income arising therefrom, and so much of the principal as they shall deem necessary for his support and maintenance, but, at his death I direct that the principal remaining of such trust fund shall be divided between my children as named in this paragraph of my will; In case any such children shall

parent's share; In case any of such children shall die without issue before my decease or the decease of my husband, David Fisher, then the share of such child shall be divided equally between my children as named in this paragraph of my will, and their issue per stirpes.

Lastly, I hereby nominate, constitute and appoint David Fisher and Mamie May, executors of this my last will and testament, hereby revoking all former wills and testaments by me heretofore made, and I do authorize and empower my said executors, or the survivor of them to grant, bargain, sell and convey any and all real estate owned by me at the time of my decease, upon such terms and in such manner as they shall deem to be to the best interests of my estate.

In Witness Whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this fifteenth day of April, Nineteen Hundred and Sixteen.
