

NEW WOODWORK'G PLANT PLANNED BY NEW CONCERN

Vermont Woodcrafters To Construct Building On Barre Street

Construction of a wooden one-story plant, 80 by 40 feet, on Barre street at the site of the stonished of the United Granite company which was destroyed by fire some years ago, will be started Monday by Vermont Woodcrafters, Inc., of Montpelier, it was announced today by President Perry H. Merrill.

It is planned to complete construction by June 1 and to manufacture toys, wood turnings, and novelties. When operations are fully developed, it is estimated that between 20 and 30 people will be employed.

Vermont Woodcrafters, a recently organized corporation, has purchased the business of the Brassaw Novelty Manufacturing company, developed by the late Frank H. Brassaw and carried on in the past at 38 Elm street. It will retain the services of John Martin as plant foreman, in which capacity he was employed by the Brassaw company.

The business of the Brassaw Novelty company, another concern conducted by the late Mr. Brassaw, is being continued by his widow, and the Brassaw Novelty company has been purchased by Mr. and Mrs. Elvezio Caslani.
