

George W. Buswell

George William Buswell, Sr., 68, native and life long resident of Montpelier, died Saturday night about 7:30 at Heaton hospital, where he was taken Friday night. He had been ill only a few days.

Born May 24, 1883, he was the son of the late Charles Fremont Buswell and Emma (Murphy) Buswell. He attended the local schools and graduated from Montpelier Seminary in 1903. Mr. Buswell was then associated with his father in the Buswell Book Store on Main st., and after his father's death he continued a stamp dealers business started by his father. For five years he was employed as caretaker at the recreation field and more recently he had worked part time at the Cross Baking Co.

In 1908 he married Miss Emma LeClair in Barre and the couple had lived at 29 East State st. for many years.

Mr. Buswell was an athlete, playing basketball while at the seminary and later with local teams, including that of the former National Guard quintet. He was a member of the Episcopal church.
