Edwin S. Meigs

Edwin S. Meigs, 88, died in Coral Gables, Florida, Wednesday following a short illness.

Born in Swanton in 1874, Mr. Meigs lived and was employed for many years in Montpelier. He entered business in Florida in 1923 in partnership with the Parker Art Printing Press. He was married to the former Julia Allard who died last year.

Survivors are his son Harry and two daughters, Mrs. Marion Henshaw and Mrs. Edna Tomlinson, all of Coral Gables, Florida, seven grandchildren and 17 great-grandchildren.

Funeral services are this afternoon at 4 o'clock from the Philbuck Funeral Home. Interment will be at the Woodlawn Cemetery with the Dade County Guard of Honor.

Mr. Meigs was a veteran of the Spanish American War and the Philippine Insurrection. He was the oldest past potentate of Mount Sinai Shrine and a life member for 50 years. He was a member of all Masonic bodies. He was made an honorary member of the Aloha Temple of Honolulu, Hawaii. He was a charter member and a life member of the Montpelier Elks.

Since 1923, Mr. Meigs has returned to Vermont for two months during the summer, living at his camp at Marshfield.
