

### NEW BOTTLING WORKS

**Misko Seal Beverage Company Is Name of New Concern To Begin Business in Wedge Block.**

The Misko Seal Beverage company is the name of a new soda water concern which will begin business about the middle of February or March 1 in the Wedge building on Berlin street. James M. Twiss, for 11 years with the William Miller bottling works, is the principal in the new concern which already has ordered a complete outfit which is expected to arrive very shortly.

Mr. Twiss completed his labors yesterday for the Miller estate and today set to work to get his new plant in shape.

Among the goods ordered is a Magic carbonater, a Lowe automatic washer and soaking machine and a Junior automatic filling machine using a crown cork which has a capacity of 60 cases an hour. Everything in connection with the plant will be new and modern, and its owners intend to have it one of the best equipped in Vermont. Particular attention is given to the sanitary arrangements so as not to have either syrup or fluids exposed to the air or outside influences. A carload of bottles has been ordered together with a lighter case than is in general use which proves an item on return freight and express charges. The bottle washing machine is considered one of the most perfect in use, insuring the making of bottles 100 per cent clean.

Mr. Twiss learned the bottling business under Mr. Miller, taking Elmer E. Pattee's place, Mr. Pattee now succeeding him in his old position. Mr. Twiss is thoroughly familiar with every detail of the business, knows the trade, and the success of the business is confidently expected by those who are interested in installing the modern equipment in the new plant.
