

SPECIAL CEREMONIAL

As a Tribute to Charles Heaton, Senior Recorder of the Shrine in the World

The next ceremonial session of Mt. Sinai temple will be held in this city May 23 and will be the official recognition of the 53rd anniversary of the election of Charles H. Heaton as recorder of the temple. An announcement of the celebration planned in honor of Mr. Heaton who is a charter member of the temple has been sent to all members by Illustrious Potentate William L. McKee of this city.

Mr. Heaton in addition to being a charter member of the local temple

is also the oldest living recorder in the shrine in North America. As a part of the program planned in honor of Mr. Heaton the temple is planning to initiate 53 new members into the organization.

A new roster has been recently issued by Recorder Charles H. Heaton of Mt. Sinai temple and contains the names of more than 1,600 members of the temple. The list includes residents of nearly every state in the United States and several of the provinces of Canada. There are also listed the names of several who are residents in foreign countries. The roster is the first complete list of the members of the temple to be issued in more than six years.
