

Montpelier Businessman Everett Wyman, 78, Dies



Everett H. Wyman, 78, of 41 River St., Montpelier, died Monday in Central Vermont Hospital, Berlin where he had been a patient about a week. He was the retired founder of Wyman's Inc.

Born in Randolph, May 25, 1902, he was son of Frank E. and Mae (Howe) Wyman.

He moved to Montpelier in 1920, and was employed by the Lane Manufacturing Co. until 1927 when he started Wyman's Inc.

In 1966, he sold the business after 42 years of management. In 1962, he started a branch in Randolph, Maine which he also sold in 1966.

He married Emily Warren in 1922. She died in 1929.

In 1938, he married Catherine Carle, who died in 1963.

He married Kathryn Soper in 1967.

Besides his widow, he leaves

Mr. Wyman was a member of Aurora Masonic Lodge 22, a 32nd degree Scottish Rite Mason, King Solomon RAM Chapter 7, Barre Council R&SM 22, Mt. Zion Commandery 9, Knights Templar; Mount Sinai Shrine Temple 3, being a former member of its Patrol; the Ianis Shrine Club, White Mountain Shrine Club, Sun City Central Shrine Club, a life member of Montpelier Elks Lodge 924 and a member of the Petroleum Equipment Institute of North America. He was interested in civic affairs, the Central Vermont Humane Society and the Shrine Hospitals.

His funeral service will be held Thursday at 2 p.m. in Trinity United Methodist Church.

Entombment will be in the family mausoleum in the Berlin Corner Cemetery.
