- Too busy working to become an AKC conformation champion, Rex was the lead dog on the Truckee plane rescue & the “City of San Francisco” snow bound train rescue.

- “Nate” was the first big winner for Aladdin Samoyeds and took many BOBs from large entries.

- He was ranked among the top six Samoyeds for five years.

- Jade was out of Ch. Aladdin's Dominator.
- A consistent winner, took many BOBs, Group placings, and Specialty wins.

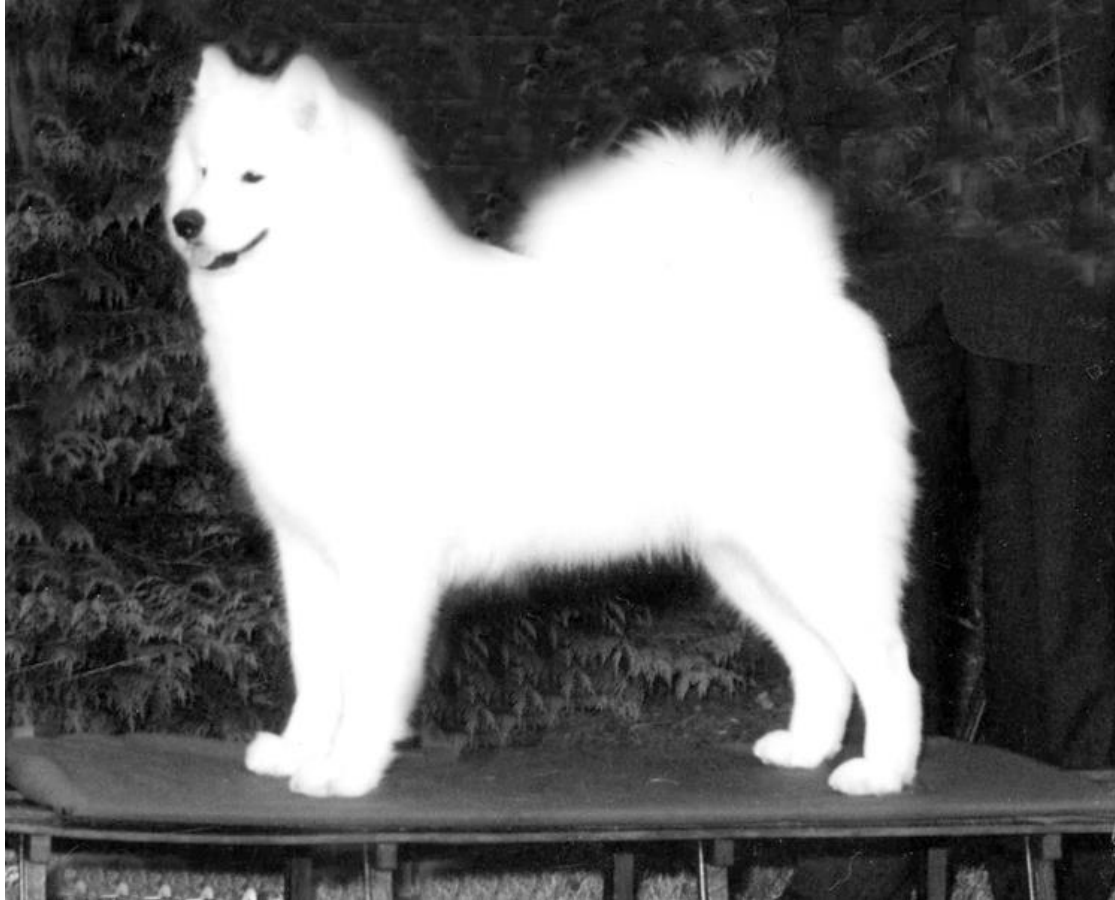

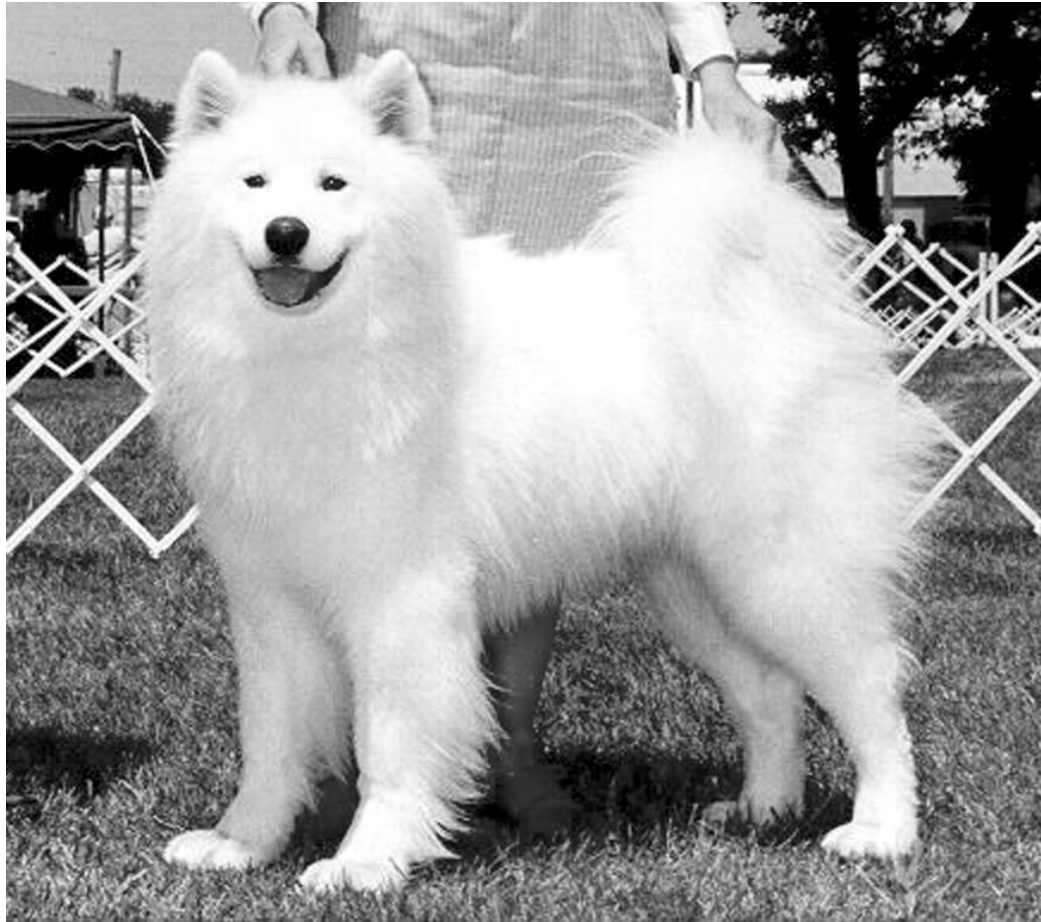

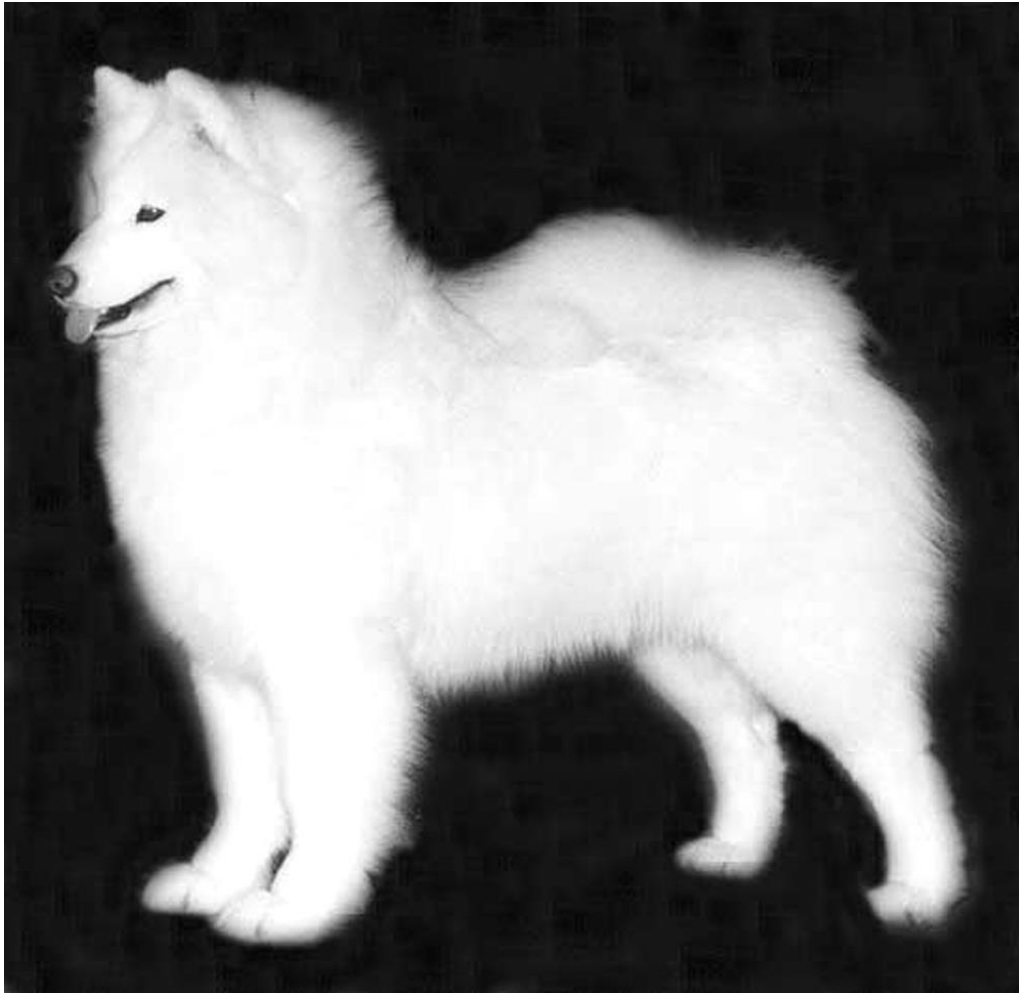

- SCA's top-winning Samoyed and the number 6&7 Working Dog for 1989 and 1990.
- Won at the nation's largest and most prestigious shows.
- 3 Consecutive Westminster KC Best of Breed wins (1989-1991) and last of only 5 Group placings ever awarded to a Samoyed (Group 4 in 1991)

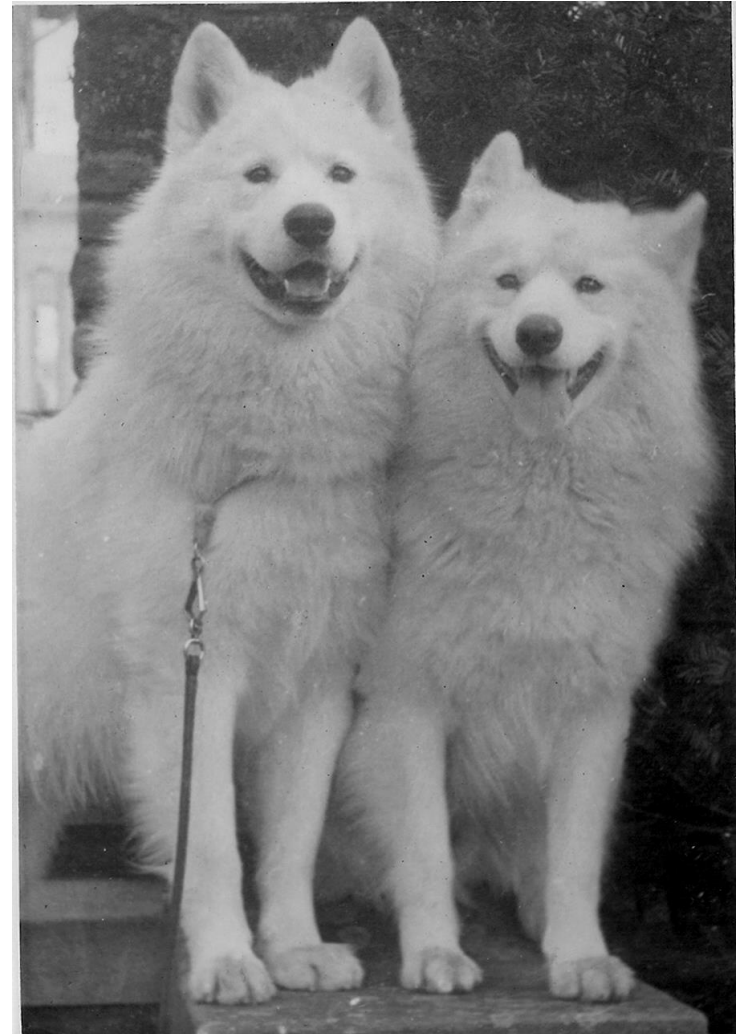

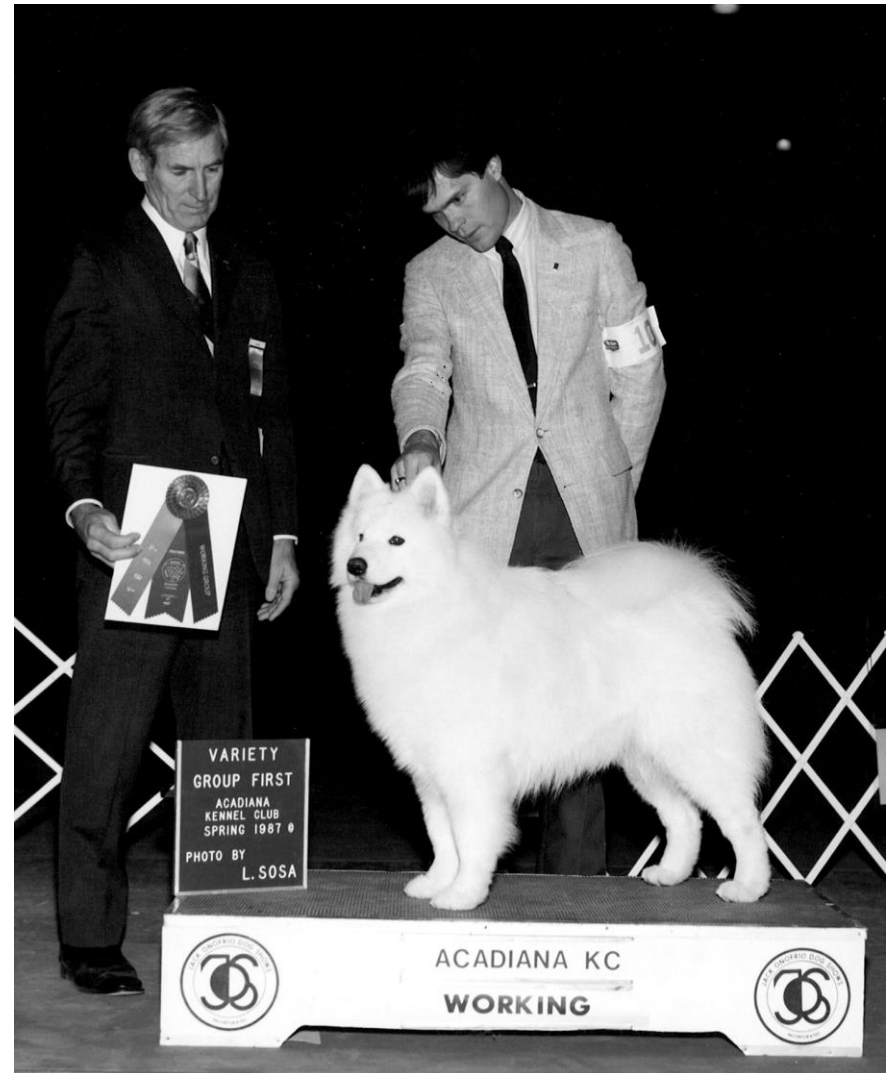

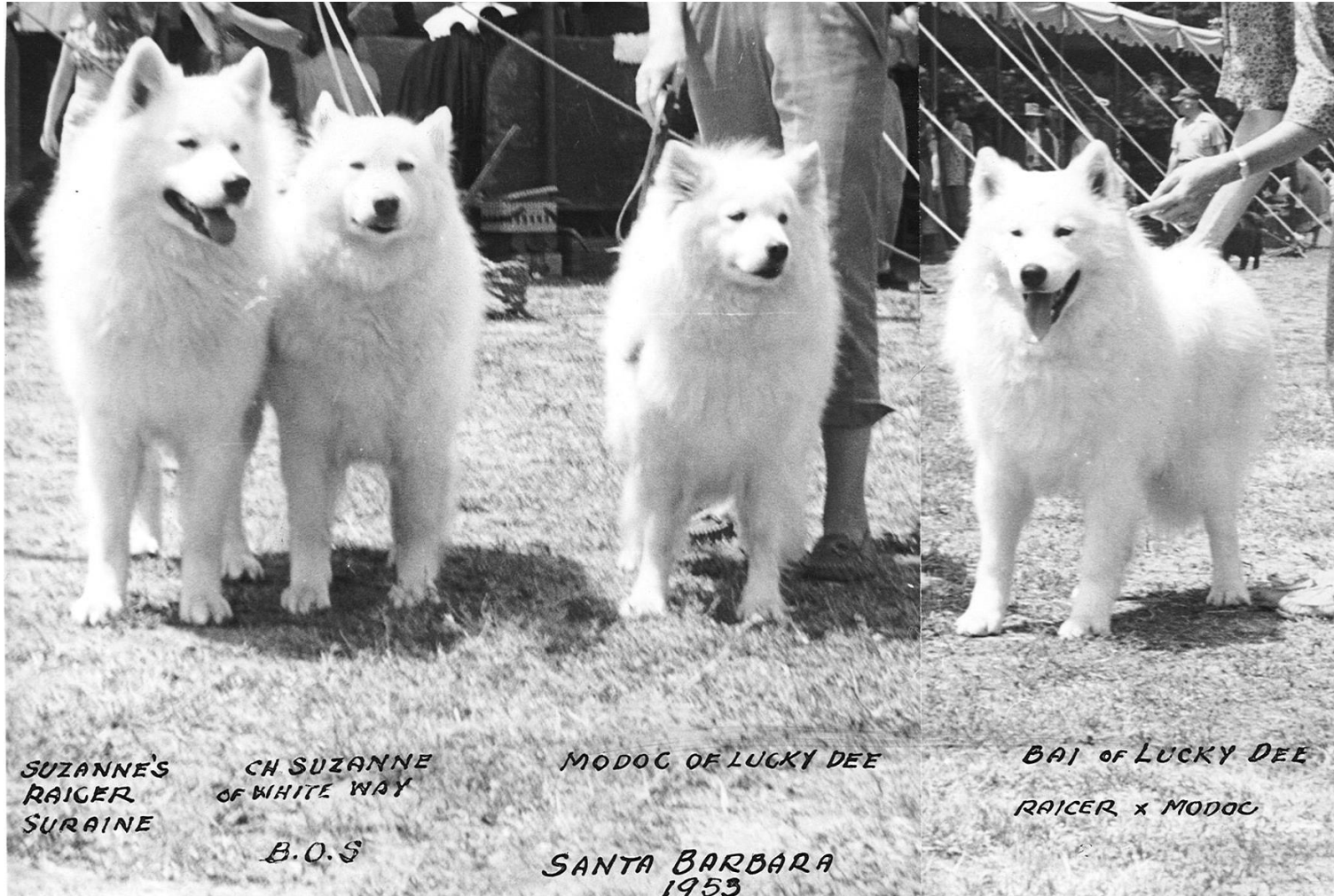
