We purchased "Chief" when he was almost nine months old. Helen Spathold had located our foundation bitch, Jinka (Ch. Cnejinka) for us a year or so before that time and we had asked her to help locate just the right mate for Jinka. She had located a couple of nice boys but not just what we wanted. She called one day and said she had found "our boy". He was a son of her Rocky (Ch. Rokandi of Drayalene) and she thought probably his very best. We purchased him without any further discussion.

Chief has been shown very few times but he does have three group placings. He is an extremely dominant sire and usually you can tell a Chief son or daughter by looking at them. He has not been used at stud nearly as much as most people think; but we have always tried to breed him with good quality bitches that can produce the type puppies we like to have out as "Chief kids". He has about 140 sons and daughters at this time. Eleven of these have their American championships and two have Canadian titles. He has 29 others pointed and 39 have their OFA numbers.

We are very proud of our "Chief".

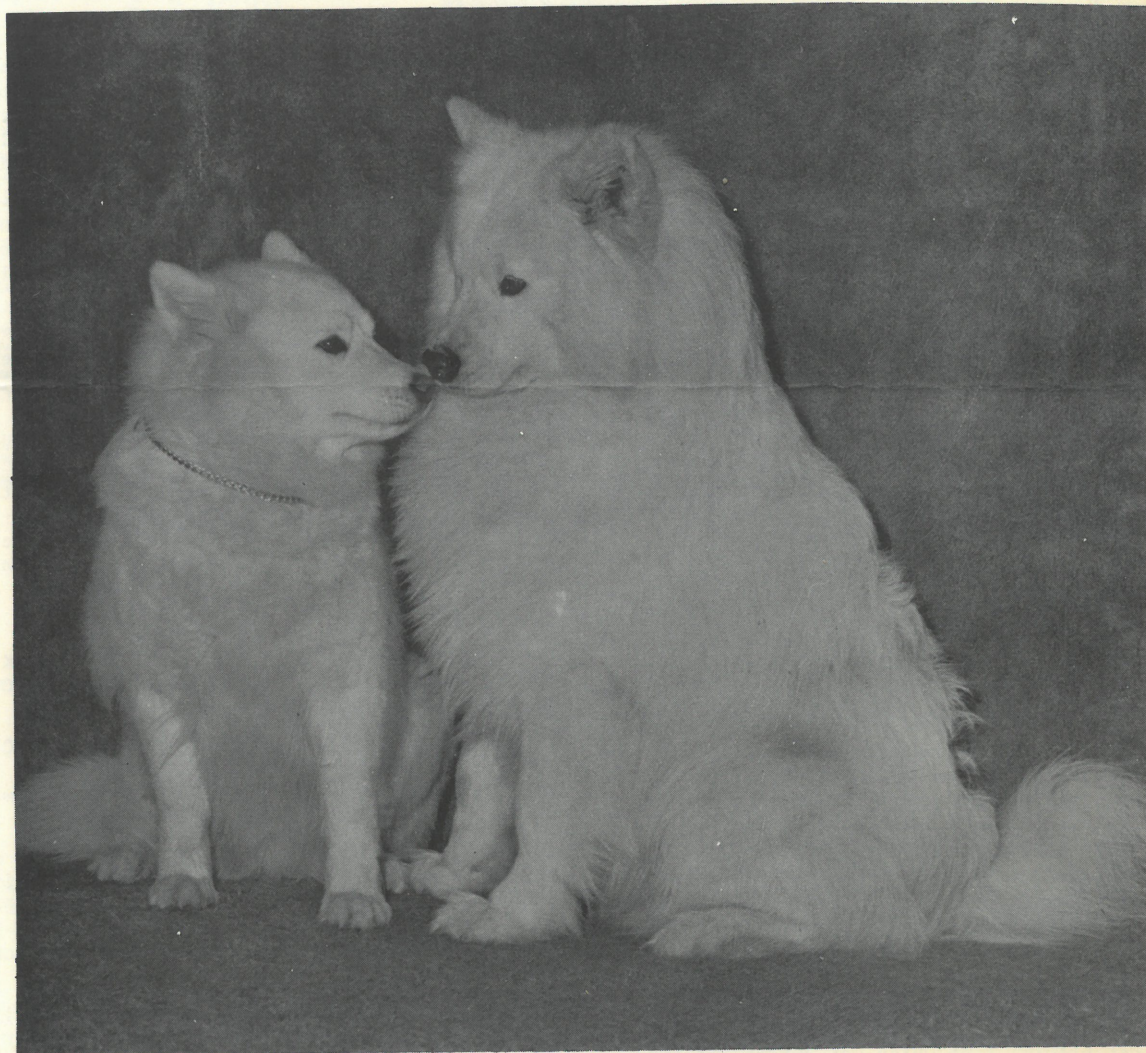

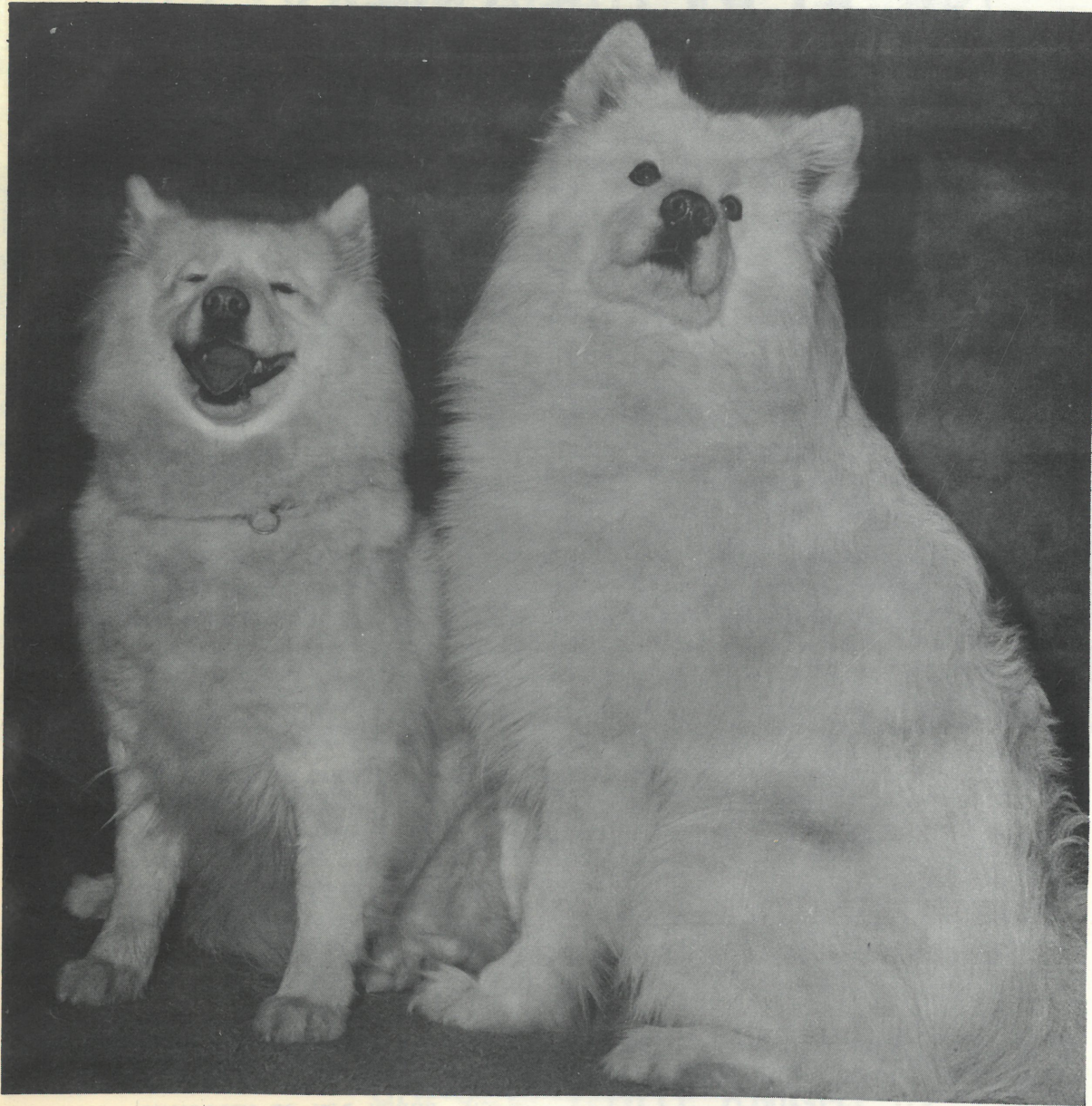

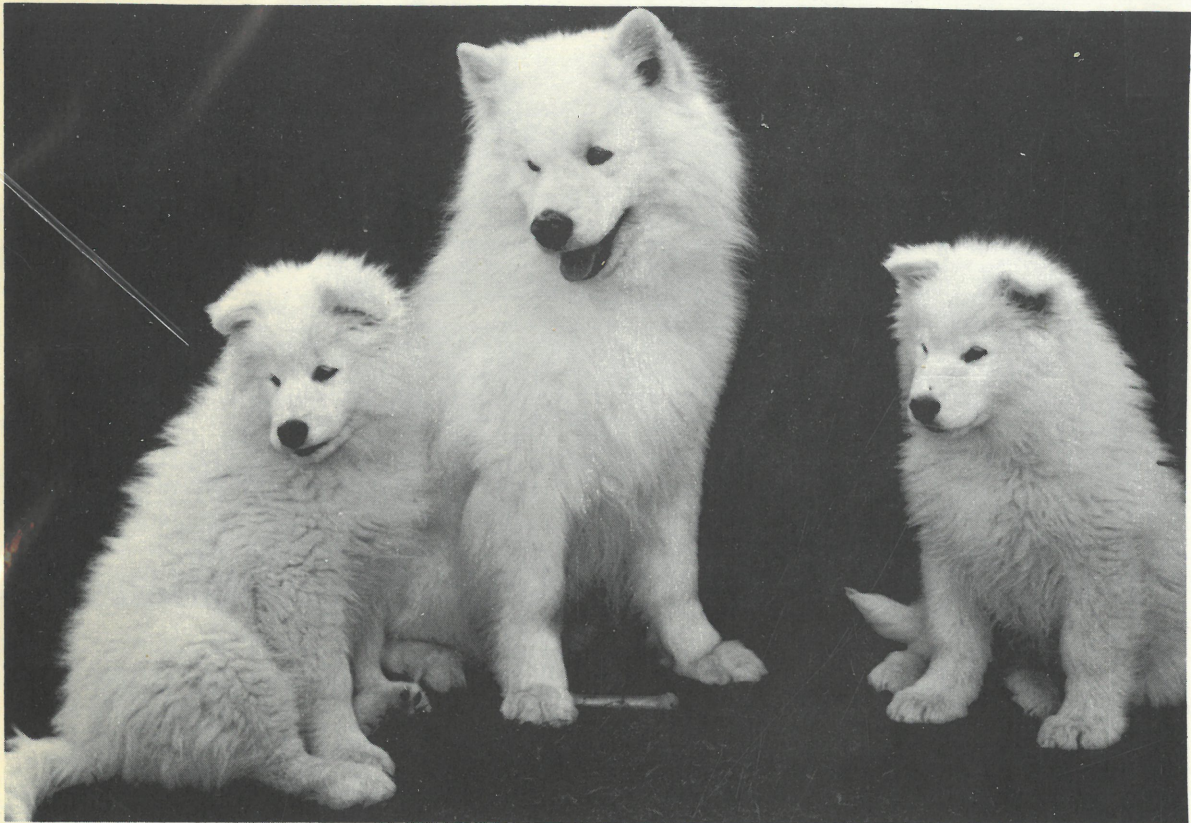

He is the lover, never the fighter. His most aggressive time is when he is tired of Yogi pulling his tail for attention and then he may lift his lip to get this nonsense stopped. He loves little thing; this past summer he located a gopher and all the time the gopher was chewing up Chief's nose, he was careful not to hurt his prize as he brought it to us to see. Chief has 14 American Champion sons and daughters and four with Canadian titles, as well as 34 others with points. 57 of his "kids" have their OFA normal number. He has sired a total of 178 puppies, the youngest are three weeks of age and the oldest just turned seven. Four of his get have placed in the working group for 7 placings. Chief is a "Top Dog"...show, producer and pet.

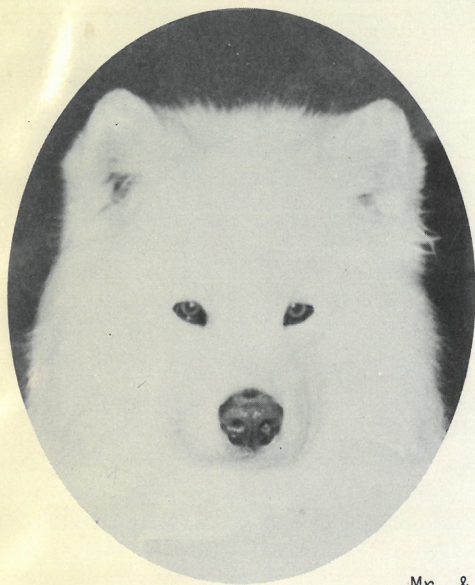

Ch. Nachalnik of Drayalene, "Chief," is the top producing Samoyed in the history of the breed. The following notes on Chief are by his owners, Harold and Doris McLaughlin.

Chief was purchased at seven months of age from Helene Spathold, a Samoyed AKC judge from California. Chief was the stud service puppy by her Ch. Rokandi of Drayalene and out of Drayalene's Charisse.

Chief was Helene's last and, according to her, the best of her years of breeding. She passed away shortly after shipping Chief to Silveracres.

Before Chief, Helene had found us a top quality bitch, Cnejinka. Her eye for top quality Samoyeds must have been good as Ch. Cnejinka produced 9 champions from her total of 15 puppies.

Chief was never a "hot shot" in the ring. He made his championship in 16 shows. He had two group placements from the classes. He was only specialied once. Even when he was being shown, he was a better producer than a winner. His first champion son, Zamaraski, finished before he did.

Chief's record as of November 1976 is 44 champions. This includes 35 AKC champions, 7 Canadian champions and 2 Mexican champions. With 48 more of his get pointed, he will have many more

champions before his record tops out. He is the top producing Samoyed in the history of the breed and it is not likely that this record will ever be broken.

To set the record straight on how often Chief was used at stud at Silveracres, here are the facts. Chief was bred to 52 females, including those owned by Silveracres. This produced a total of 281 puppies. At last count, 128 of these had their OFA number. So Chief was not only a great producer of champions, he was a great producer of clear champions. Chief's stud fee was always kept low so that we could chose quality bitches for him. No one ever paid over \$150 to breed their bitch to him.

Chief was the Top Producer (Samoyed Club of America) for the years 1969, 1970, 1973, and 1974. His son, Ch. Kondako's Dancing Bear, was the Top Producer for 1972 and 1975.

On the winning side, Chief's daughter, Am. & Can. Ch. Kipperic Kandu of Suruka Orr, C.D. is the top winning Samoyed bitch in the history of the breed, with two all-breed Best in Shows and one specialty Best in Show.

Chief had an outstanding temperament and was dominant for it. He was one of the great ones.

Just three weeks after taking Best of Breed at the National Specialty (first bitch to win since 1964) Kandi took Best in Show at Janesville, Wisconsin, the first Samoyed bitch to go BIS in the U.S. since 1954.

We are truly proud of Chief and all his kids.

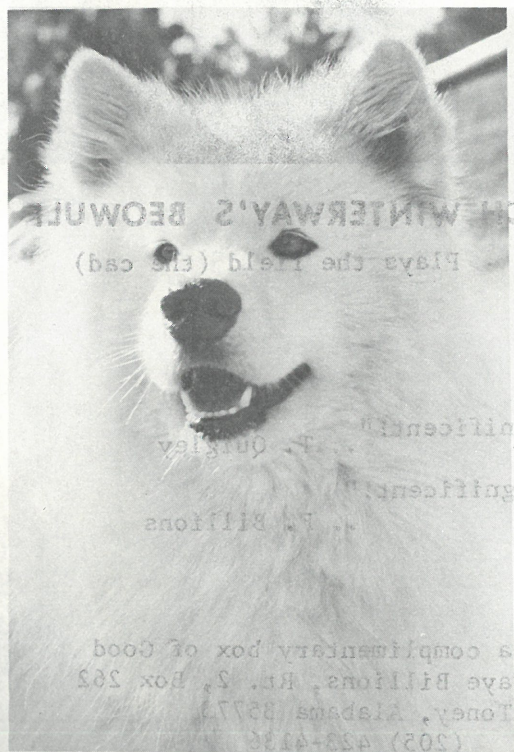
CH. NACHALNIK OF DRAYALENE Sept 16, 1961 — May 26, 1975

A litter of seven puppies was born at Drayalene Kennels thirteen years ago. It was the last litter ever to be born there. Out of that litter one puppy was stolen and never seen again, one bitch was spayed, four puppies became AKC champions, and the other puppy now has fourteen points. At least three of the puppies later placed in the working group. The primary accomplishment of that litter was not in the show ring, however. One of those puppies will soon be the top producing Samoyed stud dog of all time: Ch. Nachalnik of Drayalene.

Nachalnik (Russian for Chief) was the Spatholds' pick of the litter. Chief was the stud fee for the breeding, so he stayed on at Drayalene when the other puppies went to their new homes. Chief's puppyhood must have been unhappy. He suffered distemper at a very early age. Scars on the lenses of his eyes were the result of this disease. Mr. Spathold was very ill when Chief was quite young. Even though Doris and Harold M^cLaughlin bought Chief at the age of seven months, they let him stay at Drayalene for two months as a companion to the dying man. Following the death of Mr. Spathold, Chief moved to his new home at Silveracres.

Chief's show career was not outstanding, although he placed in the working group twice from the classes. He fulfilled the requirements for his championship, but was shown as a special only once. One of his sons went Best of Breed that day, so Chief retired from the show ring.

Chief was one of the gentlest dogs at Silveracres. Once, when Chief was attacked by a dog, Harold had to drag the other dog away. Chief licked the dog's face as soon as the fight was over. Chief often brought wild animals home for Doris and Harold to see. A gopher once objected to going to "show and tell", and chewed on Chief's nose all the way home. Chief had a cauliflower nose for the rest of his life, but Doris was presented with a live gopher. The only time that Doris can remember seeing Chief really mad was when Cnejinka killed a chipmunk that Chief was bringing to Doris. Chief did not speak to Cnejinka for several days.



Chief displayed many of the original Samoyed traits. He really enjoyed people, and he had a natural talent for sled pulling. His herding ability was displayed when he rounded up a couple of very scared calves that had fallen from a truck. Without any commands or assistance, Chief brought the calves to Doris. It was the first and only time that Chief ever saw cattle.

Fame really came to Silveracres and Chief when his puppies entered the show ring. He was Top Producing Samoyed Stud Dog in 1969, 1970, and 1973 (various rating systems each year), and he has an excellent chance for all the rating systems this year. He and Ch. Cnejinka produced the first all OFA clear litter of any breed. Chief was OFA SA11. At present, one hundred six Chief kids have OFA certificates. Eighty-nine others are under the age for certification. There are twenty-seven AKC champions and eight Canadian champions bearing Chief's name as sire. That, alone, ties Chief for top producing Samoyed ever in the history of the breed. Thirty-eight more Chief kids have points toward their championships.

Chief produced other top producers, such as Ch. Kondako's Dancing Bear and Silveracres Mona Lisa. Chief is the sire of the top winner — Am. & Can. Ch. Kipperic Kandu of Suruka Orr, C. D. Other sons and daughters of Chief have become the foundation for many of the best known kennels in North America. Nachalnik of Drayalene was the sire of puppies living in every state of the Union, including Alaska and Hawaii, and in Germany, France, and Puerto Rico.

People all over the world are proud to have Chief's puppies. He produced puppies that are fine examples of what Samoyeds are supposed to be. Chief will be famous for the puppies he produced, but he will be remembered by Doris and Harold as the best pet anyone ever had.

Ch. Nachalnik of Drayalene, "Chief," is the top producing Samoyed in the history of the breed. The following notes on Chief are by his owners, Harold and Doris McLaughlin.

Chief was purchased at seven months of age from Helene Spathold, a Samoyed AKC judge from California. Chief was the stud service puppy by her Ch. Rokandi of Drayalene and out of Drayalene's Charisse.

Chief was Helene's last and, according to her, the best of her years of breeding. She passed away shortly after shipping Chief to Silveracres.

Before Chief, Helene had found us a top quality bitch, Cnejinka. Her eye for top quality Samoyeds must have been good as Ch. Cnejinka produced 9 champions from her total of 15 puppies.

Chief was never a "hot shot" in the ring. He made his championship in 16 shows. He had two group placements from the classes. He was only special once. Even when he was being shown, he was a better producer than a winner. His first champion son, Zamaraski, finished before he did.

Chief's record as of November 1976 is 44 champions. This includes 35 AKC champions, 7 Canadian champions and 2 Mexican champions. With 48 more of his get pointed, he will have many more

champions before his record tops out. He is the top producing Samoyed in the history of the breed and it is not likely that this record will ever be broken.

To set the record straight on how often Chief was used at stud at Silveracres, here are the facts. Chief was bred to 52 females, including those owned by Silveracres. This produced a total of 281 puppies. At last count, 128 of these had their OFA number. So Chief was not only a great producer of champions, he was a great producer of clear champions. Chief's stud fee was always kept low so that we could chose quality bitches for him. No one ever paid over \$150 to breed their bitch to him.

Chief was the Top Producer (Samoyed Club of America) for the years 1969, 1970, 1973, and 1974. His son, Ch. Kondako's Dancing Bear, was the Top Producer for 1972 and 1975.

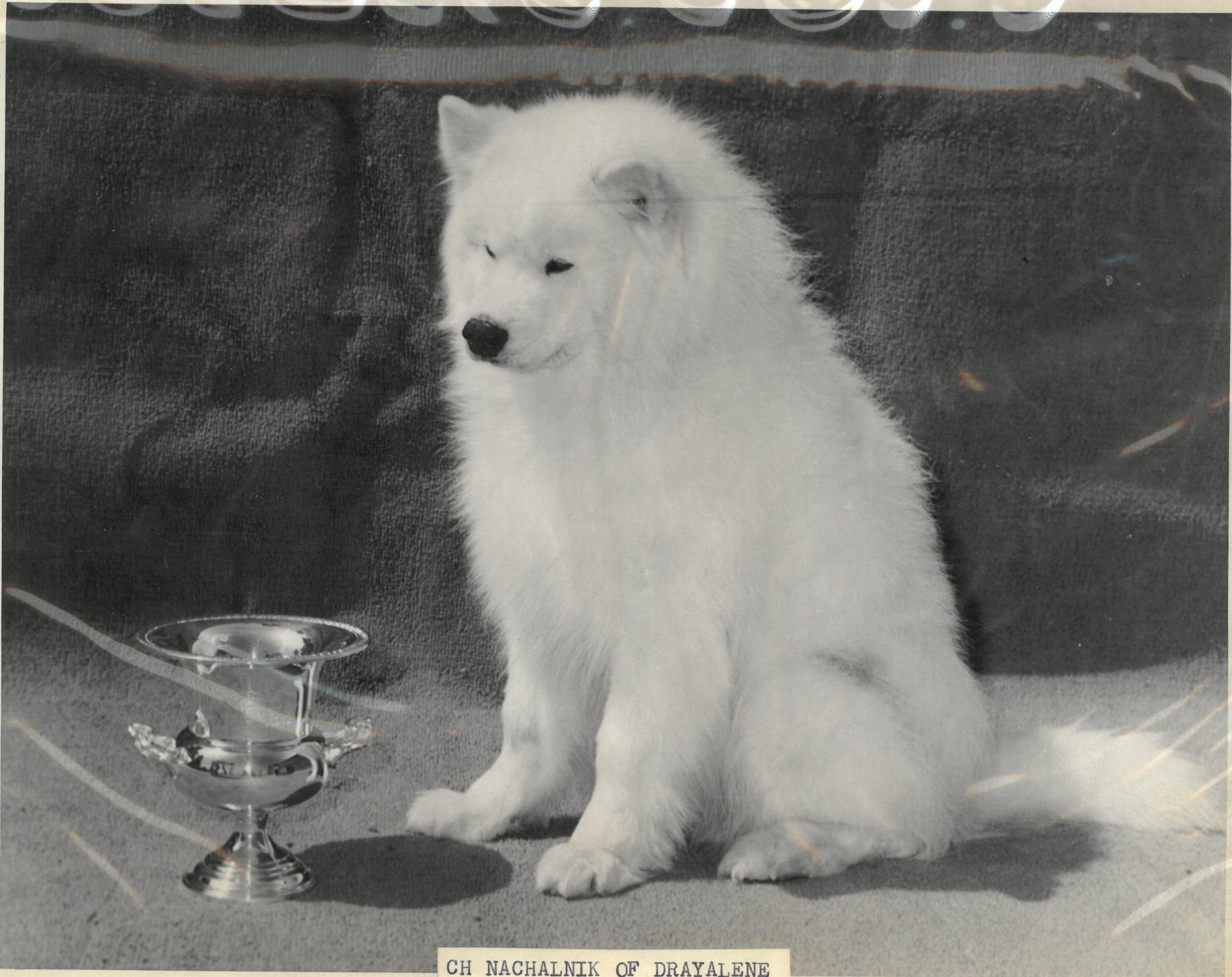
On the winning side, Chief's daughter, Am. & Can. Ch. Kipperic Kandu of Suruka Orr, C.D. is the top winning Samoyed bitch in the history of the breed, with two all-breed Best in Shows and one specialty Best in Show.
