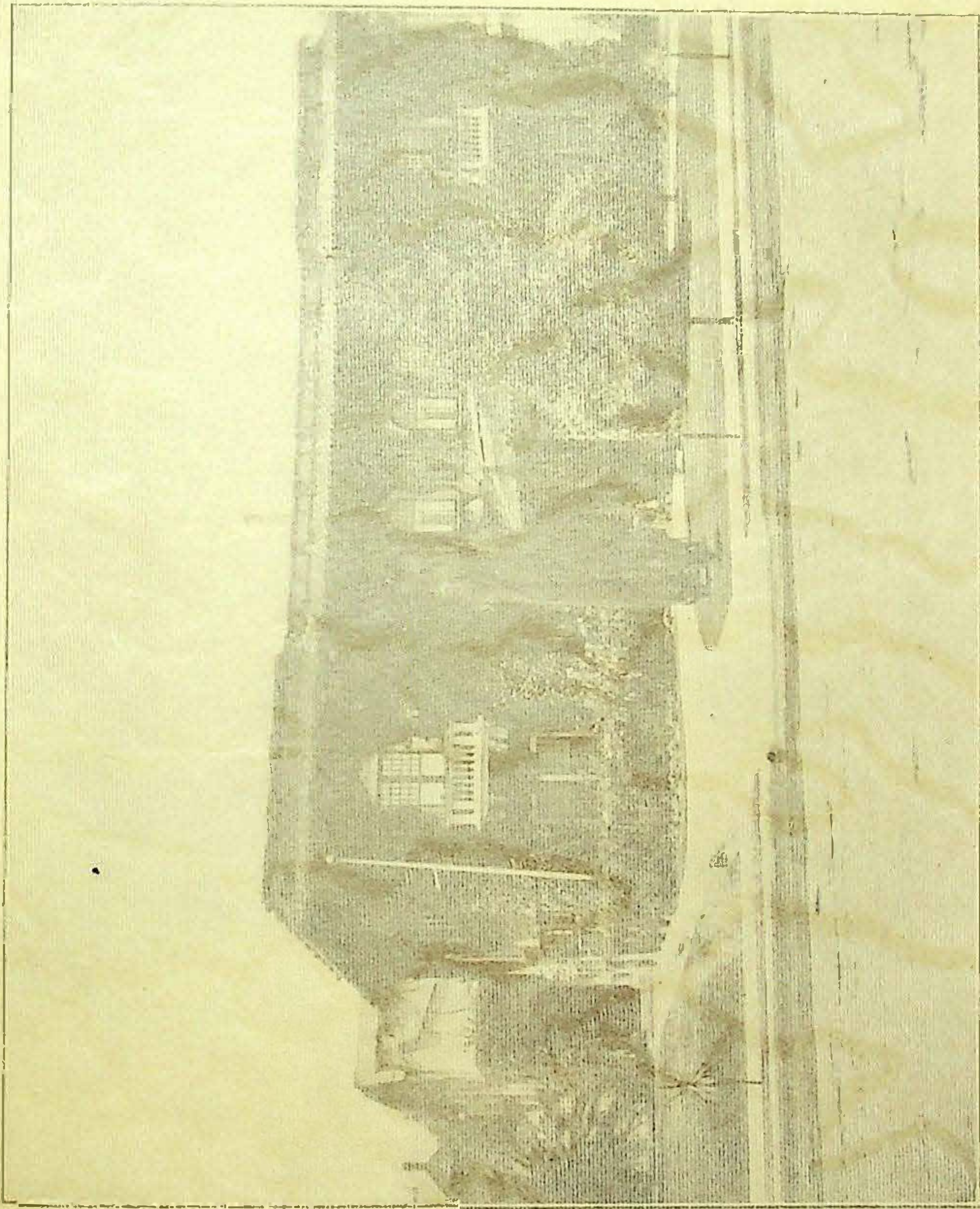
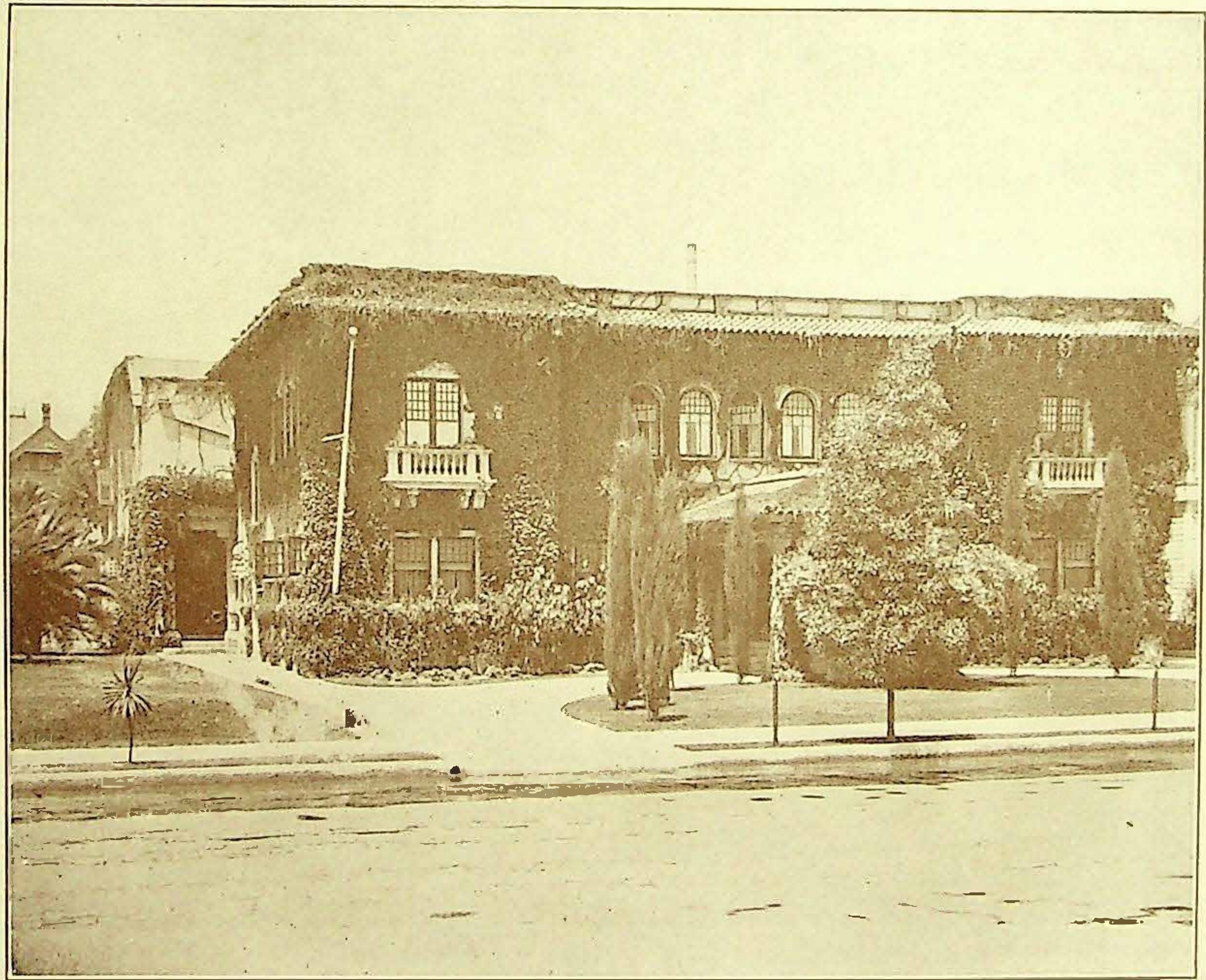

The Ebell

Dr. Adrian Ebell, a distinguished German scholar, realizing woman's limited opportunity for mental development and the necessity of fitting her to cope more effectively with the strenuous and complex forms of modern life, conceived the idea of establishing an international academy with headquarters at Berlin and tributary chapters in all parts of the world, for the object of developing feminine mentality along serious and scientific lines.

The first of the several chapters on the Pacific Coast bearing his name was the Oakland Ebell, organized in 1876. The Los Angeles Ebell, established in 1894, with its central organization and various study departments, was modeled upon the same lines as this admirably planned Mother Club.

Each of these great music dramas is explained with the special view of bringing before the minds of the audience what actually takes place at the best performances, and at each lecture-recital a program of the music is rendered on the pianoforte. References are frequently made to the interpretations given by the great singers. In order to make the course more inclusive, Wagner is shown not merely as the superb musician, but as the dramatist, poet, philosopher, and deep ethical teacher.

The aim of the Director is so to train the artistic faculties that each of his hearers may become a cultured musician, able to appreciate the beautiful in music, and ready to exercise a keen, judicious, and always sympathetic criticism.

The course should commend itself to the beginner as well as to the advanced, to the pianist, the vocalist, the student of musical form and instrumentation, and to those wishing to become acquainted with Wagnerian traditions.

Part of each meeting will be in charge of the director of current topics, and will be devoted to reports on recent achievements of science.

Annual Report of the Recording Secretary

With the earnest desire and the lofty ambition to bring to her members that "broad culture which comes through service to others," Ebell has surely accomplished much during the past year toward the attainment of her cherished ideals.

The Monday afternoon programs, thirty-six in number, have been varied, entertaining and instructive. There have been eighteen lectures, nine musicales, four plays and five readings. Nine programs have been furnished by members of the Club, besides three afternoons provided by Sections—the Books and Conversation, the Science and the Music Sections. No programs during the year have been more thoroughly enjoyed than those given by our own members.

Among the lectures given two treated of National Problems, one on the "Immigration Question" by Robert Watchorn, and the other a symposium, "The American Negro, The American Highlanders, Mormonism and Immigration."

Our knowledge of world-wide affairs was increased by five lectures on "Current Events" by Mrs. Lou V. Chapin.

With stereopticon we were carried by Dr. Bruce Gordon Kingsley into the realm of music and introduced to some of Wagner's Heroes and Heroines.

A literary day of special interest was a resumé of "Southern Literature Since the War," by Dr. James A. B. Sherer.

Prof. Hector Alliot entertainingly presented "Modern Handicraft," and an afternoon never to be forgotten was spent with those heroic conquerors of the air, Messrs. Dick Ferris, Knabenshue, Willard and Har-

ri-son. A subject coming close to the heart of every woman was discussed by Mr. Joseph Scott in his lecture on "Some of the Relations of the Home and the School." We learned in a lecture on "The Weather Bureau and its Work" that the records are used for many important purposes, and our anxiety was alleviated by Mr. B. R. Baumgardt's assurances in his stereopticon lecture on "Halley's Comet" that the earth would not meet with destruction when passing through the comet's tail.

Two very helpful lectures were given on woman, one by Dr. David Starr Jordan and the other by Dr. Charles Edward Locke. No more pleasing address was delivered during the year than that of Mr. L. E. Behymer on "Reminiscences of Musical and Dramatic Celebrities," while to Mrs. Lillian Burkhart-Goldsmith we are indebted for a most delightful program which was a happy blending of lecture and reading on the theme, "The Art of Great Artists."

The musicales have been of an exceedingly high order, four of them were given by our own members or under their direction, namely: Miss Margaret Goetz, Madam Elsa von Grose Menasco, Mrs. E. W. Martindale and Mrs. Sidney B. Webb, Mrs. Harmon Ryus and Miss Goetz. Mention of Madam Frieda Langendorff recalls an unusually attractive afternoon with this famous Queen of Song; and to Mrs. Grace Widney Maybee and Mr. Harry Girard we offer grateful acknowledgement. The Shrine Quartet, and a Song Cycle under the direction of Mr. Archibald Sessions were greatly enjoyed. Others who have participated in musical programs are Mrs. Tessie Cook Haskins, Miss Helen Thresher, Master Vernon Bettin, Mrs. W. J. Kirkpatrick, Dr. Bruce Gordon Kingsley and Mrs. Margaret La Grange.

To lovers of the dramatic art the readings and plays have given genuine pleasure, notable among them being the tragical Bible story of "Judith and Holofernes" by Mrs. Katherine Oliver McCoy, and "The Dawn of a To-morrow" by Mrs. Edith Adams Stewart. We

were pleased to listen again to an original production by Miss Wilamene Wilkes in "The Choice." Our own members whom it is always a delight to hear gave the following programs: "The Heart of Old Hickory," Mrs. Hite Wickizer; "Miss Civilization," Mrs. Lillian Burkhart-Goldsmith, and "The Happy Pair" arranged by Mrs. C. L. Higbee.

The Children's Christmas party under the management of Mrs. B. R. Baumgardt and Mrs. Samuel V. McClure brought much merriment and happiness to hundreds of Ebell's Children. After the presentation of a Christmas play Miss Hazel Rundge sang a group of songs and little Miss Winifred Jones, five years old, played several piano compositions written by Mozart at that age. Even in their merry making these young folks were taught the value of our motto, "I serve," as each was requested to bring a gift for some less fortunate child. It is safe to assert that no Christmas party was ever more deeply appreciated than that enjoyed by the two hundred and thirteen settlement children the next day in their automobile ride and entertainment.

The pleasure of our Monday afternoon meetings has been greatly enhanced by the social hour in the Tea rooms, when the House Committee, under the supervision of Mrs. Fred Selwyn Lang, dispensed a genial hospitality. There have been eight parties, including the Charter Day Reception, the Arts and Crafts Exhibit, Reception for Mr. and Mrs. Robert Mantell, Reception with the Friday Morning Club for Mrs. Josiah Evans Cowles, Mrs. L. B. Torrey's eightieth birthday party and the Annual Club Luncheon.

There are nine organized departments carrying on commendable work in their respective lines. The Department of Parliamentary Law has held ten meetings for Drill with the Curator, Mrs. Matthew S. Robertson. Four excellent lectures have also been given by Hon. W. O. Morton on "Some Points of Law of Interest to Women."

The Department of Expression, Mrs. William L. Jones, Curator, has held fourteen meetings. Questions of right living and character, suggested by Emerson and Ruskin were discussed.

The Department of Shakespeare, Mrs. F. W. Beau de Zart, Curator, and Mrs. Edward North, Instructor, devoted fourteen meetings to the careful, analytical study of the tetralogy of English kings.

The Art and Travel Department with Mrs. George H. Mosher, Curator, and Miss Alice E. Mitton, Instructor, still retains its place as the banner section for attendance. Fourteen days were spent in visiting the cities, lakes, palaces and art galleries of Italy.

The members of the Department of Music with Mrs. Harmon Ryus and Mrs. E. W. Martindale as Curators, and Dr. Bruce Gordon Kingsley as Director, have been enthusiastically appreciative of the lectures given on Wagner's "Ring of the Niebelung."

The Department of Science under the efficient leadership of Mrs. Jay B. Millard, has held seven meetings. Topics of physical and metaphysical science have been discussed by those prominent in their respective lines of work.

The Department of Books and Conversation has also held seven meetings, the programs of each being in charge of some member of the section. Mrs. Sidney J. Parsons as Curator has carefully looked after the general interests of the section. The work has shown a tendency toward the discussion of general topics rather than special books.

The Department of French, Mrs. M. H. Boehner, Curator, has held twenty-nine meetings. Prof. Gabriel Durnerin, as instructor, has faithfully led the three classes through the difficulties of learning a new language.

The Department of the Drama was organized late in the year with Mrs. Ada H. Van Pelt as Curator. Four meetings were held and the outlook is very promising for an interesting and successful section.

The Club Library has been increased by the pur-

chase of forty-four books and the gift of several volumes.

Through the beneficent efforts of the Committee on Civics and Philanthropy the Club has been led into good works. Assistance has been given to the Barlow Sanitarium, the Maternity Hospital, the Ocean Park Home, Associated Charities and the Anti-Tuberculosis Fund. A donation of seed potatoes was made for the settlement children, while the use of the Club House has been donated for the McKinley Home Benefit and also for other benevolent purposes.

We acknowledge with sincerest appreciation many beautiful and valuable gifts to the Club from Mrs. F. W. Johnson, Mrs. E. C. Magauran, Mrs. Henry Valk, Mrs. P. G. Hubert, Mrs. Reuben Shettler, Mrs. Katherine Kimball Forest, Miss Helen Louise Kimball, Mrs. Elmer E. Cole, Mrs. Augustus Hine, Mrs. Benjamin Thorpe, Mrs. F. S. Langdon, Mrs. H. L. Story, Mrs. Charles Prager, Miss Winifred Waite, Mrs. L. Otis Shaw, the Shakespeare Section and the Art and Travel Section.

Our financial interests have been encouragingly improved, the Club having purchased this year \$5890.00 worth of Ebell Building Association Stock, the total number of shares now owned by Ebell being 2344.

One hundred forty-five new members have been received during the year; eight qualified as Life members, twenty-six as Associate and seventeen as Temporary. Twenty-one members have resigned and two have become delinquent. The Death Angel has removed eight members from our ranks, bringing sorrow to our hearts. The total number of regular members now is one thousand and twenty-nine. At the Monday afternoon programs four thousand four hundred and forty-seven guests have been entertained.

Thus we rejoice in a year of unprecedented activity and prosperity.

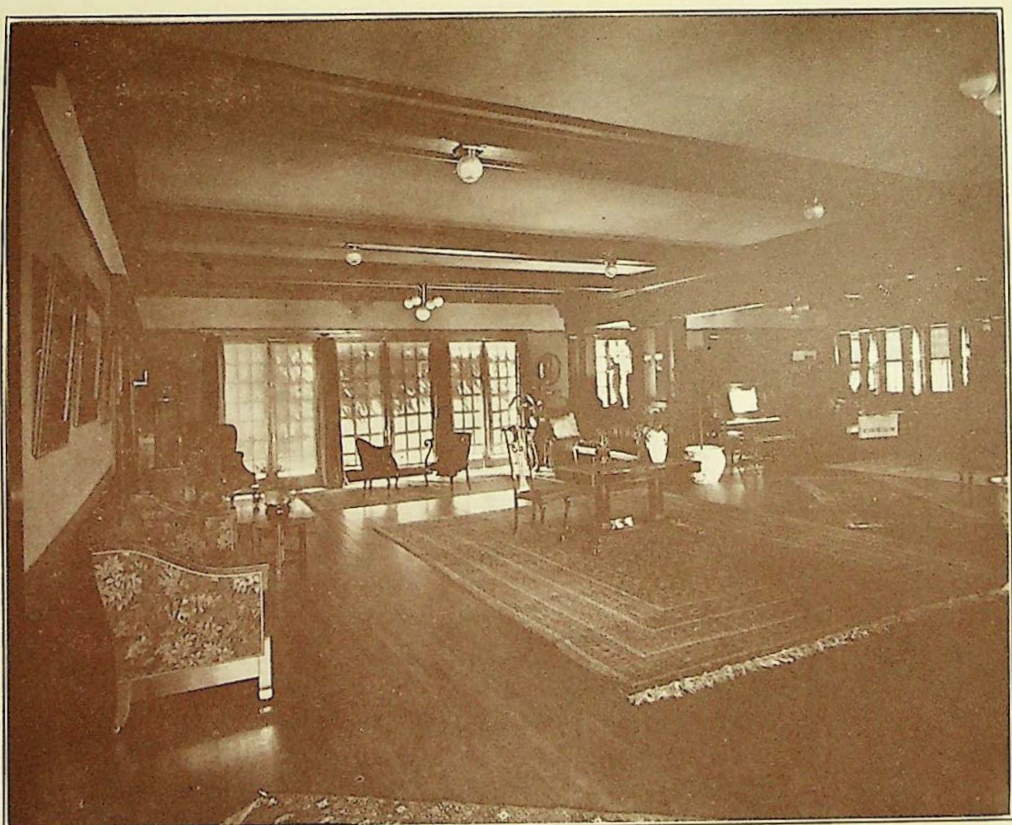

Seventh—That, pursuant to a call therefor, this association was organized at a meeting duly held at 1054 Flower street, in the City of Los Angeles, County of Los Angeles, State of California, on the twenty-sixth day of June, A.D. 1897; and it was then and there resolved to proceed to incorporate this said association; and an election was then and there duly held for the election of directors of this said corporation; that a majority of the members of the said association were then and there present, and voted at the said election, which said election resulted in the choice of the above named directors of the corporation; all of which is more particularly set forth in the certificate and verification by the officers conducting the said election, hereto annexed, and made a part and portion of these articles of incorporation.

By-Laws

Article I

The incorporate name of this Society shall be The Ebell of Los Angeles.

Article II

The object of this Society is advancement in all lines of general culture.

Article III

The officers of this Society shall be a President, three Vice-Presidents, a Corresponding Secretary, a Recording Secretary, a Treasurer, and a General Curator. These officers with its Board of seven Directors (one of whom shall be the President) shall constitute the Executive Committee.

Article IV

Powers and Duties of Directors

Section 1. The powers of this corporation, except as herein otherwise provided in the By-Laws, are vested in the Board of Directors.

Sec. 2. The Board of Directors shall consider and control all permanent matters, i. e., financial investments, disbursements, and all established matters that pertain to the life, welfare and methods of the Society.

Sec. 3. The Directors shall appoint their own Secretary from their number.

Sec. 4. Resolutions passed by the Directors shall be handed in writing to the Executive Committee to be entered on their minutes.

Article V

Section 1. The Executive Committee shall arrange and control the current affairs of the Society, receive the reports of all committees and act upon them. The chairman shall report matters of general interest at the business meetings and at the annual meetings of the Society.

Sec. 2. The Executive Committee shall incur no indebtedness beyond the necessary current expenses of the Society.

Sec. 3. Five members shall constitute a quorum.

Sec. 4. Any vacancy occurring in the Executive Committee shall be filled by the Board of Directors.

Sec. 5. The Curators of the Sections shall constitute an Advisory Board to be called upon when required by the Executive Committee.

Article VI

Duties of Officers

Section 1. The President shall be chairman of the Board of Directors and of the Executive Committee; shall preside at all meetings, call all special meetings, appoint all committees, sign all bills authorized by the Executive Committee, and make an annual report.

All appointments of committees made by the President shall be subject to the ratification of the Executive Committee.

The President shall exercise supervision over all the affairs of the Society, and shall be an honorary member of all committees. In the absence or disability of the President, her duties shall be assumed by the Vice-Presidents in the order of their rank. In the absence of the presiding officers, if a quorum is present, a temporary chairman may be appointed.

Sec. 2. The First Vice-President shall be chairman of the Program Committee.

The Second Vice-President shall be chairman of the House Committee.

The Third Vice-President shall be chairman of the Membership Committee.

Sec. 3. The Corresponding Secretary shall be ex-officio chairman of the Printing Committee, and shall attend to the correspondence of the Society and issue all notices ordered by the Executive Committee. She shall assist in the preparation of the Year Book.

Sec. 4. The Recording Secretary shall keep the minutes of the meetings of the Society, and of the Ex-

ecutive Committee, and shall submit a report at the annual meeting, sign all bills and corporation papers. She shall hand to all Committees their instructions in writing.

Sec. 5. The Treasurer shall have charge of all the funds of the Society; shall pay all bills audited by the Executive Committee; shall submit a report of all receipts and expenditures monthly to the Executive Committee, and annually to the Society, and to the Board of Directors when called upon. She shall give a bond for the faithful performance of her duties to the Society in such sum as the Board of Directors may require, which bond shall be executed by some reliable security company. The cost of obtaining said bond shall be defrayed by the Society.

Sec. 6. The Curator shall keep posted upon the Bulletin Board in the rooms of the Society a statement of the time and place of all Section meetings, and any information which may be of general interest to the members of the Society. She shall ascertain which Section a new member desires to enter. She shall receive application for the formation of new Sections, and shall keep herself informed of the general character of the work of each Section, reporting the same to the Executive Committee monthly, and make reports of the same at the annual meeting of the Society. She is also ex-officio chairman of Committee on Sections.

Sec. 7. A Clerk shall be engaged by the Executive Committee, who, in addition to specific duties assigned her by said Committee, shall act as Financial Secretary, Librarian and Custodian of the property of the

Society. She shall keep an inventory of all such property, and deliver the same to her successor in office, requiring from her a receipt. She shall give a bond similar to the Treasurer's for the faithful performance of her duties as Financial Secretary.

Article VII

Standing Committees

Section 1. Chairmen of the Standing Committees shall be members of the Executive Committee.

The Standing Committees shall be:

1. Committee on Membership;
2. Committee on Printing;
3. Committee on Programs;
4. Committee on Sections;
5. House Committee.

Sec. 2. The Committee on Membership, upon receiving the properly endorsed names of applicants for membership, shall investigate the same and report at the next regular meeting of the Executive Committee; and shall investigate all resignations before reporting to the Executive Committee.

Sec. 3. The Committee on Programs shall see that a program is provided for each regular meeting of the Society.

Sec. 4. The Printing Committee shall attend to the necessary printing of notices, membership cards, blanks, bulletins, etc., and the Year Book.

Sec. 5. The Committee on Sections shall assist in

the organization of Sections, and advise the Curator of Sections in arranging their course of study.

Sec. 6. The House Committee shall have charge of all social occasions, buy all house supplies ordered by the Executive Committee, and supervise the building and its contents.

Sec. 7. It shall be the duty of all Committees to assist the Executive Committee.

Article VIII

Members

Section 1. An applicant for membership shall sign blank provided. Her name shall be endorsed by three regular members in good standing and of more than one year's membership. The application shall be handed to the Membership Committee. Upon receiving the endorsement of the Committee and having been posted two weeks, it shall be voted upon by the Executive Committee at its next meeting. Endorsers shall be personally responsible for applicant.

The notice of acceptance shall be sent to the proposed member by the Clerk, together with bill for admission and half yearly dues.

No member of the Society may sign more than three applications for regular membership, or more than three for associate or temporary membership, during one year.

Sec. 2. Business women, members of the Society, whose hours of business are such as to make only an occasional attendance possible at the regular meetings

of the Society, shall, upon application and the consent of the Executive Committee, have their dues remitted one-half.

Sec. 3. Any member in good and regular standing who has reached the age of seventy (70), and has been a member of this Society for five (5) years, shall, upon application to the Executive Committee, have her dues remitted.

Sec. 4. The wives of resident clergy may become regular members by having their names duly presented and upon the payment of regular initiation fee and half the annual dues.

Sec. 5. The wives of Army and Navy officers may become members by having their names duly presented and upon the payment of the annual dues.

Sec. 6. A non-resident may become an associate member for the current year by having her name duly presented and upon the payment of the annual dues. This privilege shall be extended for one year only. She shall have no interest in the management, property or assets of the corporation, nor be privileged to attend business meetings. She may become a regular member at any time by the payment of the initiation fee.

Sec. 7. A non-resident may become a temporary member by having her name presented by one member in good and regular standing, with the approval of the Chairman of the Membership Committee, upon the payment of \$2.00 per month. She shall have no interest in the management, property or assets of the corporation.

Sec. 8. Complimentary members may be elected for the current year, who may have the privilege of attending the open meetings, but not business meetings. They shall not be required to pay admission fee or dues. They shall have no interest in the management, property or assets of the corporation.

Sec. 9. Election to membership shall be forfeited unless confirmed by the payment of the admission fee within one month after notification of election as a member. A lapsed or forfeited membership may be restored by the Executive Committee upon the unanimous vote of the Committee on Membership.

Sec. 10. Any member may resign at any time upon the presentation of such resignation in writing and the payment of all back dues.

Sec. 11. Each member of the Society must sign the By-Laws before she shall be entitled to any of the rights or privileges of membership.

Sec. 12. Honorary life membership in this Society may be given by vote of the Society in recognition of distinguished services. Such honorary membership shall confer all rights and privileges to ordinary membership without payment of dues.

Sec. 13. Members in good and regular standing who resign may, upon application, receive a resignation card stating their standing.

Sec. 14. The name of any member may be dropped from the roll of membership upon the written request of twenty-five (25) regular members in good standing and the approval, by a majority vote, of the members of the Executive Committee.

Article IX

Dues

Section 1. The admission fee shall be \$25.00.

Sec. 2. The annual dues shall be \$8.00, payable in advance; one-half on the first day of October, and one-half on the first day of March, each year. Non-payment of dues for one year shall cause forfeiture of membership, but such members may be restored upon regular application and payment of back dues; if such application is made within eighteen months of lapse of membership.

Sec. 3. Any member paying \$100 shall receive a certificate of life membership and shall be exempt from payment of dues.

Sec. 4. The Executive Committee shall have authority to remit the fees and dues of any member when it shall be deemed for the best interest of the Society.

Sec. 5. Members who may be absent from the city for one year or more shall pay half the annual dues.

Article X

Meetings

Section 1. Excepting during the months of July, August and September, a regular meeting of the Society shall take place on each Monday at 2:30 p.m., at which Sections may report, papers be presented, or business be transacted.

Sec. 2. On the first Monday of each month may be held a business and social meeting of the Society for

regular members only, at which time the Executive Committee may report on business transacted and bring new business before the Society.

Sec. 3. A regular meeting of the Board of Directors shall take place on the second and fourth Thursdays at 9:30 a.m.

Sec. 4. A regular meeting of the Executive Committee shall take place on the second and fourth Thursdays at 10 a.m.

Sec. 5. The semi-annual business meeting of the Society shall take place on the first Monday in January.

Article XI

Elections

Section 1. The annual meeting for the election of directors and officers for the ensuing year shall be held on the first Monday in June. No further notice of the election shall be necessary.

Sec. 2. A nominating ballot shall be sent to every member of the Club by the 14th of April.

Sec. 3. Such ballots shall be returned by the first Monday in May, and shall be handed to the Committee on Nominations, which shall consist of three members, two of whom shall be selected by the Club members on the first Monday in May, and the third shall be named by the Executive Committee.

It shall be the duty of this Committee to notify each nominee receiving twenty-five votes, or over, of her nomination, and ascertain which candidates ac-

cept, and which decline nominations, and when ascertained, the committee shall prepare the ballot and make all arrangements for the annual election. If however, no candidate shall receive the required twenty-five votes for some certain office, the matter of supplying a name shall be left to the discretion of the Committee on Nominations.

Sec. 4. Elections shall take place by ballot, and a plurality vote shall elect.

Sec. 5. Two directors, to hold office for three years, shall be elected at each annual election. Officers shall be elected for one year. The President, by virtue of her office, is elected a director for one year.

Sec. 6. No member shall be eligible for election to the same office for more than two consecutive terms.

Sec. 7. Installation of officers shall take place at the last regular meeting in June, and they shall enter upon their duties at the regular meeting of the Executive Committee the fourth Thursday of June.

Article XII

Section 1. The Society shall be divided into departments for the study of special subjects or the carrying on of different branches of work. Such departments to be Art, Science, Literature, Language, and such others as from time to time the Society may deem advisable.

Rule 1. All members of Sections must be members of "The Ebell of Los Angeles."

Rule 2. Members wishing to form Sections must apply to the Executive Committee through the General Curator.

Rule 3. Curators shall preside at the meetings of their Sections and plan a course of study and make an annual report of the work of the previous year when called upon to do so by the Executive Committee. Section Curators shall notify the General Curator of the dates when their Sections are to meet and when they adjourn for vacation. A Curator may appoint a secretary to assist her in the Section.

Rule 4. Sections have no power to organize or disband, nor to dismiss or appoint Curators but may express a preference to the Executive Committee.

Rule 5. Sections may limit their number and close admission, by showing ability to keep their number complete. New Sections may then be formed, based on the same line of work, bearing the same name, and numbered according to order of formation, 1st, 2nd, etc.

Rule 6. All Departments are open and free to all members of the Society.

Rule 7. No Section or any officer thereof shall have power to incur any indebtedness or liability binding upon the Society, but shall defray all its expenses not properly authorized in detail by the Executive Committee.

Article XIII

All communications on business must be made in writing, and those from less than ten members must pass the Board of Directors and Executive Committee before being presented to the Society.

Article XIV

Ten members in good and regular standing may in writing at any time request special action by the Executive Committee, which will include complaints concerning neglect of duty or transcending of privilege by any officer or member, or concerning any other matter pertaining to the Society. The Executive Committee shall at once refer the communication to the Board of Directors for immediate attention, after which it shall be referred back to the Society for final vote.

Article XV

Not less than twenty-five (25) members of this Society personally attending at a regular or properly called meeting shall constitute a quorum for the transaction of business, and the power to alter, amend or repeal the By-Laws of the Society, or to add new By-Laws thereto, may be exercised at any such meeting by a two-thirds vote of such members so assembled, and any such repeal, alteration, amendment or new By-Law so adopted shall, when adopted by the Board of Directors, become effectual.

Article XVI

All meetings of the Society and of the Executive Committee shall be governed by Robert's Rules of Order.

Article XVII

The twenty-seventh day of October of each year shall be known as "Charter Day," commemorating the organization of the Society. A reception shall be given on this day, when the President of the previous year shall present the members of the Society to the newly elected officers.

Article XVIII

No notice of any of the stated meetings of this Society, or of the Board of Directors, or of any of the committees or other convening bodies of the Society, the time of holding of which are fixed by these By-Laws, need be given. Any of such meetings may be adjourned to a day certain, even though less than a quorum be present, and no further notice of such adjourned meeting need be given, and any business may be done at such adjourned meeting which might have been transacted at the original meeting. Notice of all special meetings must be given, either personally or through the mail, or by posting on the bulletin-board for such reasonable time as the officer calling the special meeting may prescribe.

THE EBELL OF LOS ANGELES

Article XIX

Whereas the provisions of these By-Laws require the signature of each member of the Ebell Society, and those who have already signed the By-Laws of the Society have, by such signing, bound and pledged themselves to abide by the laws and regulations of the Society, therefore we do hereby, in signing the same, pledge ourselves also to abide by these laws and regulations.

Article XX

A quorum to do business being present, any By-Laws may be suspended by a two-thirds vote.

The foregoing By-Laws comprise the original By-Laws of the Society, adopted at the first regular meeting on the 1st day of September, 1898, and as amended and revised from time to time by the Society up to and inclusive of June 1910. And the foregoing By-Laws have been adopted and passed in all respects in accordance with the rules of the Society at legally called meetings of the Society and of the Board of Directors, as required by law.
