Extract from By-Laws.

ARTICLE VI.

MEMBERS.

SECTION I. The names of applicants for membership must be proposed by three members in good and regular standing, one of whom shall be a charter member of 1894. The names shall be presented to the President who shall refer them to the Membership Committee. Upon receiving the endorsement of the Committee on Membership and Ethics, the Corresponding Secretary will notify the applicant to that effect, requesting her to sign and return the application blank. The Corresponding Secretary shall thereupon refer the name to the Executive Committee to be finally voted upon at the next regular or any subsequent meeting of the Executive Committee, in the order in which it has been received.

Initiation Fee is \$10.00. Dues are payable as follows : \$1.50, October ; \$1.50, March. The Treasurer is in attendance in reception room after every general meeting.
