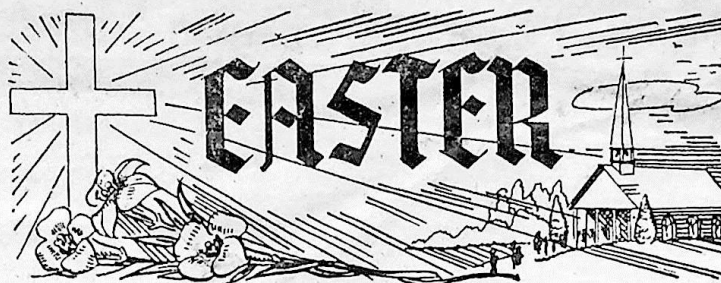
Being attendant for the Hearts Dance and being crowned queen at the Latin club banquet are her most exciting moments.
