


for the Avro VULCAN

Four "Bristol" Olympus engines make the Avro Vulcan the most powerful four-engined bomber yet flown. Like the delta-wing Vulcan, for which it is specified, the Olympus has been granted superpriority of production. The great potentialities of the Olympus turbojet were forcefully demonstrated on May 4, 1953, when an English Electric Canberra bomber, powered by two Olympus engines, established a new world altitude record at 63,668 feet . . . a height beyond the reach of any fighter in service to-day.
