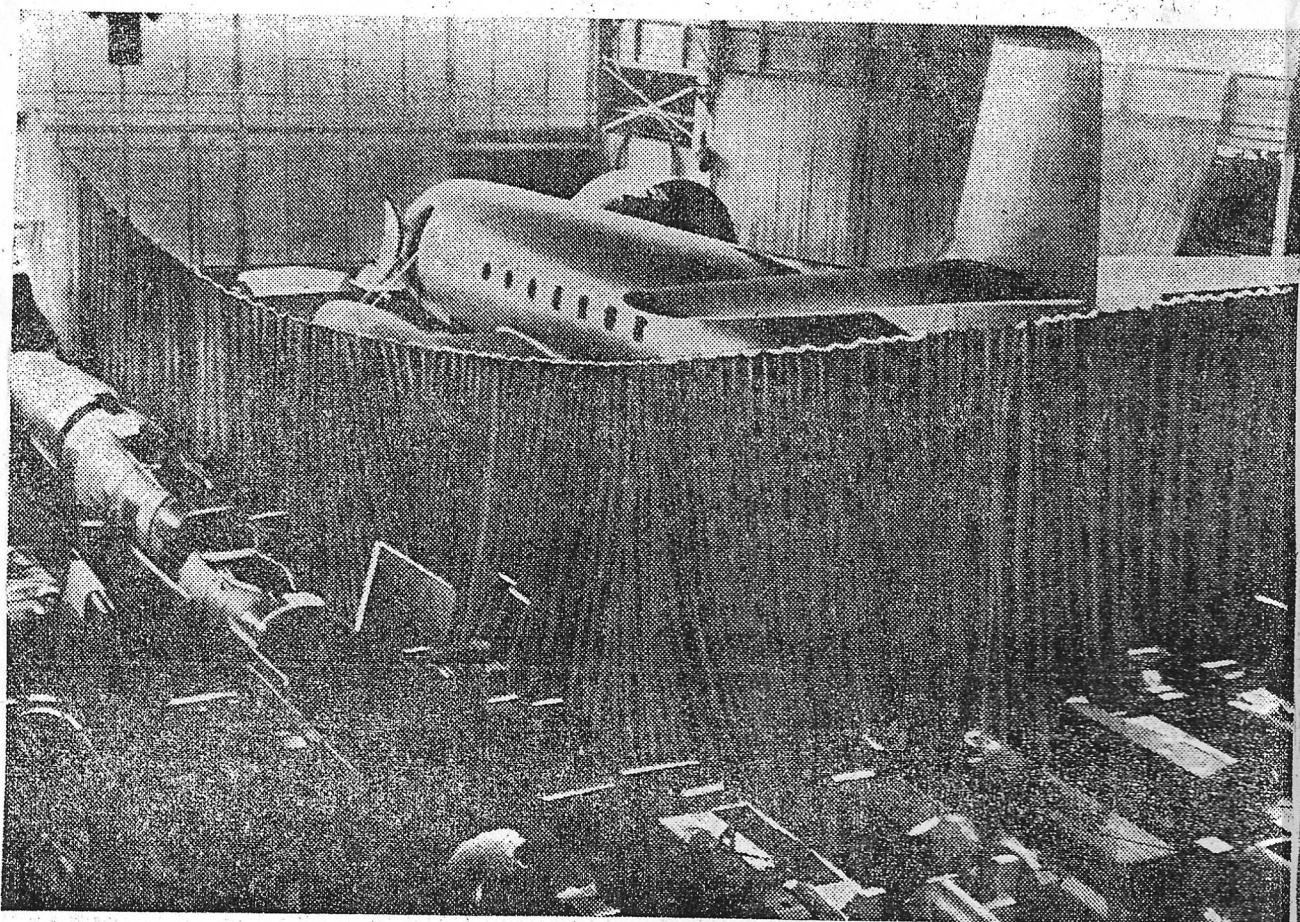
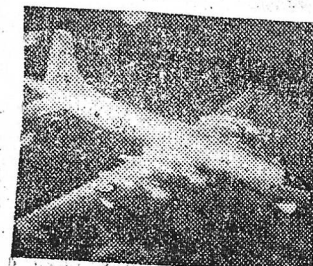


50 YEARS: *The End of an Aviation Era?*



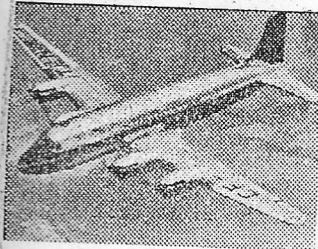

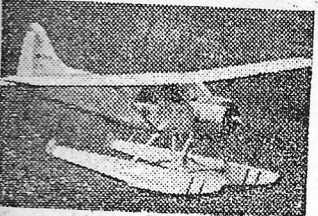

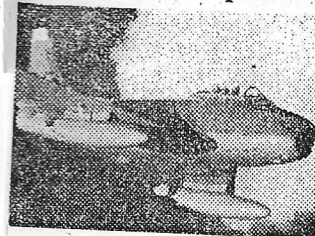

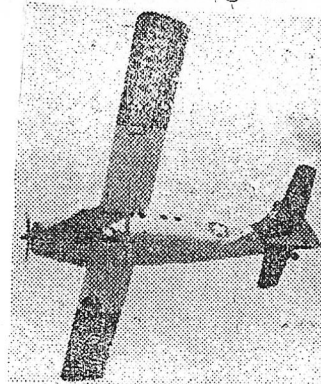

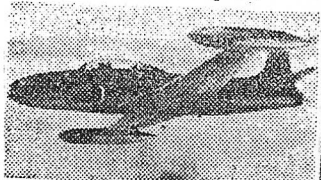

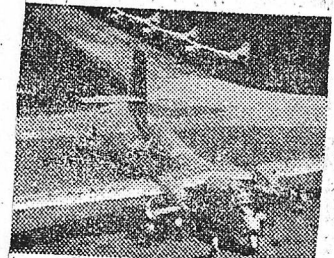

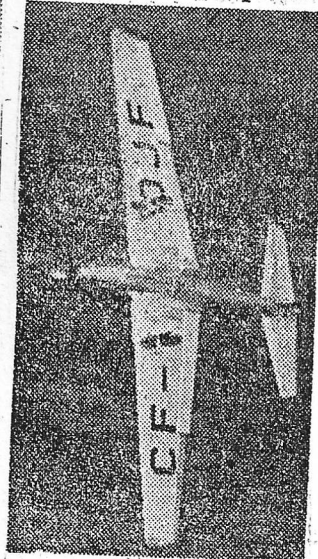

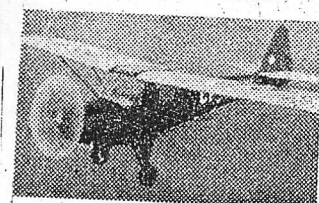

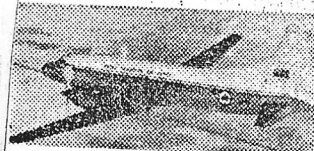

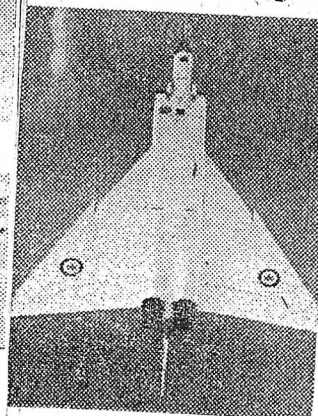
