It is with regret that I have to announce that there is to be an immediate reduction in the rate of production of the CF.100, and a consequent stretch-out of the programme.

This will unfortunately result in a reduction in our working force, mainly in the Production Departments, the great majority of which will be effected by the end of July.

Although the rate of production of the CF.100 has been reduced, it is expected that a modification programme will begin early in the fall to convert a number of MK.4's to MK.5's and later MK.5's to MK.6's.
