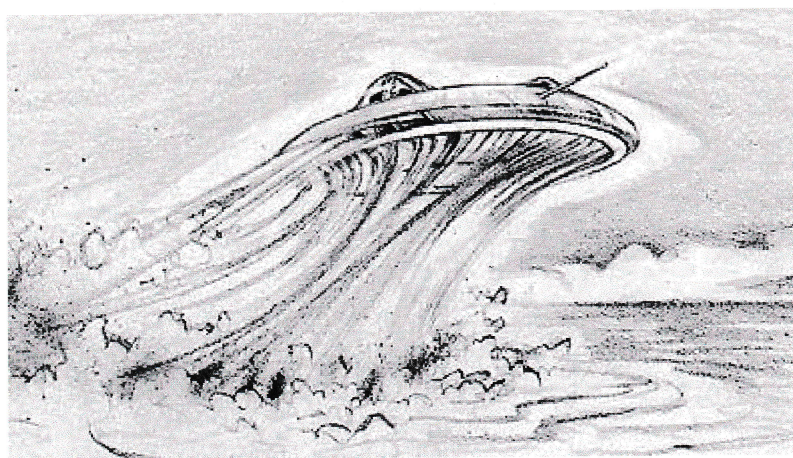


Based on earlier studies Avro Canada and built by the US Army in conjunction with that Canadian-based aircraft manufacturer, the Avrocar VZ9 was a true "flying saucer" designed to fly at speeds up to 300 miles and as high as 10,000 feet. With separate cockpits for each of its two crewmembers, the craft employed three Continental J-69 turbojet engines to power its centrally located fan. Unfortunately, the fastest the craft ever flew was 35 mph, and NASA tests concluded that its design was inherently unstable. The program was cancelled in late 1961.
