PROJECT NO. 1794

A call was made this date by B. I. Siney, MCPHBF, and Major Stephens, WCSB, to Mr. J. A. Teeter (Hudson 35505), Washington Representative for Canadian Department of Defense Production, in regards to placing a contract with A. V. Roe Limited, Toronto, Ontario, Canada. This contract will involve the disclosure of "Secret" security information.

In accordance with AF Regulation 205-42, the Washington office of Canadian Commercial Corporation, an agency of the Canadian Department of Defense Production, has the general responsibility for arranging initial facility clearances for anticipated procurements involving the disclosures of classified security information to a prospective contractor in Canada. Mr. Teeter furnished the following information and advised he would confirm same by TT to MCPHBF.

- (1) A. V. Roe has a facility clearance for access to "Secret" material.
- (2) Secret, Security clearances have been obtained for the following individuals who will be concerned with this procurement.

The work involved is of a highly classified nature and the details are furnished only on a "need-to-know" basis.

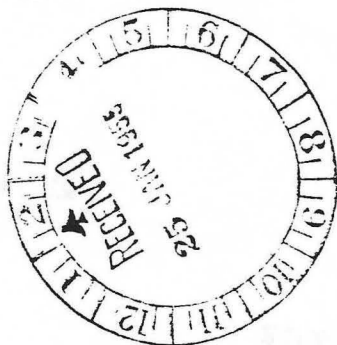
It is to be noted that Mr. J.C.M. Frost, AVRO, was the originator of this project.

The AVRO Representatives advised this would be the first contract they have had with the USAF. Mr. Douglas is somewhat familiar with our procurement procedures inasmuch as he was the Washington Representative of the Canadian Commercial Corporation for several years. Mr. Douglas was given a copy of our General Provisions for CPFF and Fixed Price R&D contracts plus copies of PARO FORMS 9-4, 9-7, and 9-9 for their information. It was recognized by the parties concerned that certain provisions did not apply to foreign procurements.

WADC had previously forwarded AVRO a copy of a proposed statement of work for Project 1794 with the thought that the firm would review same and recommend any changes deemed necessary. (WADC's work statement was based upon one originating from AVRO) The USAF is procuring a "feasibility study" on this project and future procurements will depend upon the outcome of the evaluation of this procurement. AVRO was told that the work statement as now drafted would not necessarily be the one used for negotiation purposes. It is anticipated that ARDC may, within the next few days, make certain changes thereto.

In accordance with AFPI 6-251, it is necessary that the proposed procurement be cleared with the Defense Research Board, Canadian Joint Staff, Washington, D.C. It is understood they are already aware of the pending procurement and authorization has ~~already~~ been given per a letter from the Chairman of the Defense Research Board to Mr. T. Gardner, Office of the Secretary, Department of the Air Force.
