1. The advantages and disadvantages of a press release on subject contract are still under consideration by the USAF. The disadvantages currently appear to overcome the advantages, but the matter of a press release has not yet died completely. It is considered advisable, therefore, to have a newsitem prepared and coordinated in the event instructions to release it are received. (UNCL)

2. The release proposed by the WADC Public Information Office is as follows:

"The Air Force announced today it has signed a research and development contract with AVRO Aircraft, Limited, Ontario, to obtain analytical design and test results of a proposed new aircraft. Size of the contract is approximately \$785,000." (SECRET)

3. The contractor's comments on this proposed release are requested. Assurance has been given that any release will be made simultaneously by your firm and the USAF. (UNCL)

4. Until issued to the press, the release carries the classification of "Secret". (UNCL)
