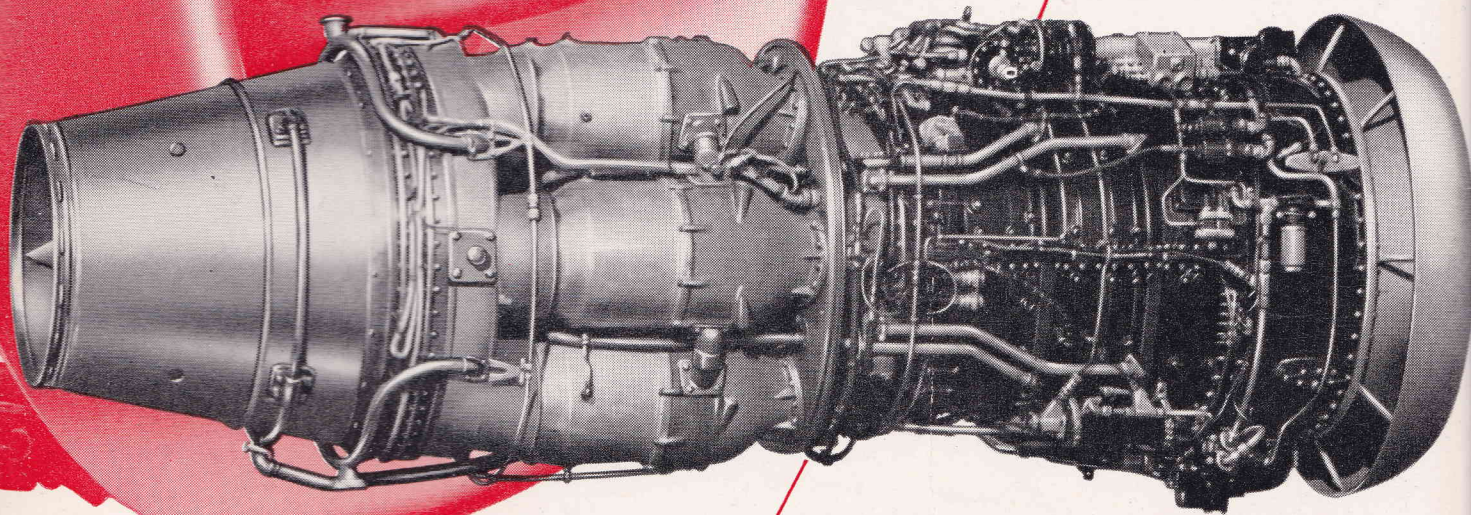




powerhouse for peace

Testing of the ORENDA continues night and day as work proceeds on building a gas turbine plant for the mass production of ORENDAS to power the front line fighters for the R.C.A.F.



In specially equipped test-houses engineers and technicians check ORENDA engines being run under continuous full throttle speeds. Hundreds of hours of exacting test-bed running are required before each power plant is approved for actual flight tests.
