

# Tool Designers Of Arrow Job To Form Co-op

The tool design department of Avro Canada Ltd. will remain a group despite the collapse of Malton operations in the face of government cancellation of the Arrow program.

This decision was reached yesterday at a meeting of the 30 members of the department, at which a co-operative organization known as New Venture Designs was formed.

The new organization decided to seek work and premises as a co-operative, and suggested it was capable of handling jobs in the fields of aircraft, automobile, production tooling design or mechanical drafting.

Decision to form the co-operative was based on a desire to maintain the "team which has successfully designed the tooling used in the manufacture of the Arrow," and because members felt they have the "initiative and technical know-how to satisfy the industrial needs of Canada."
