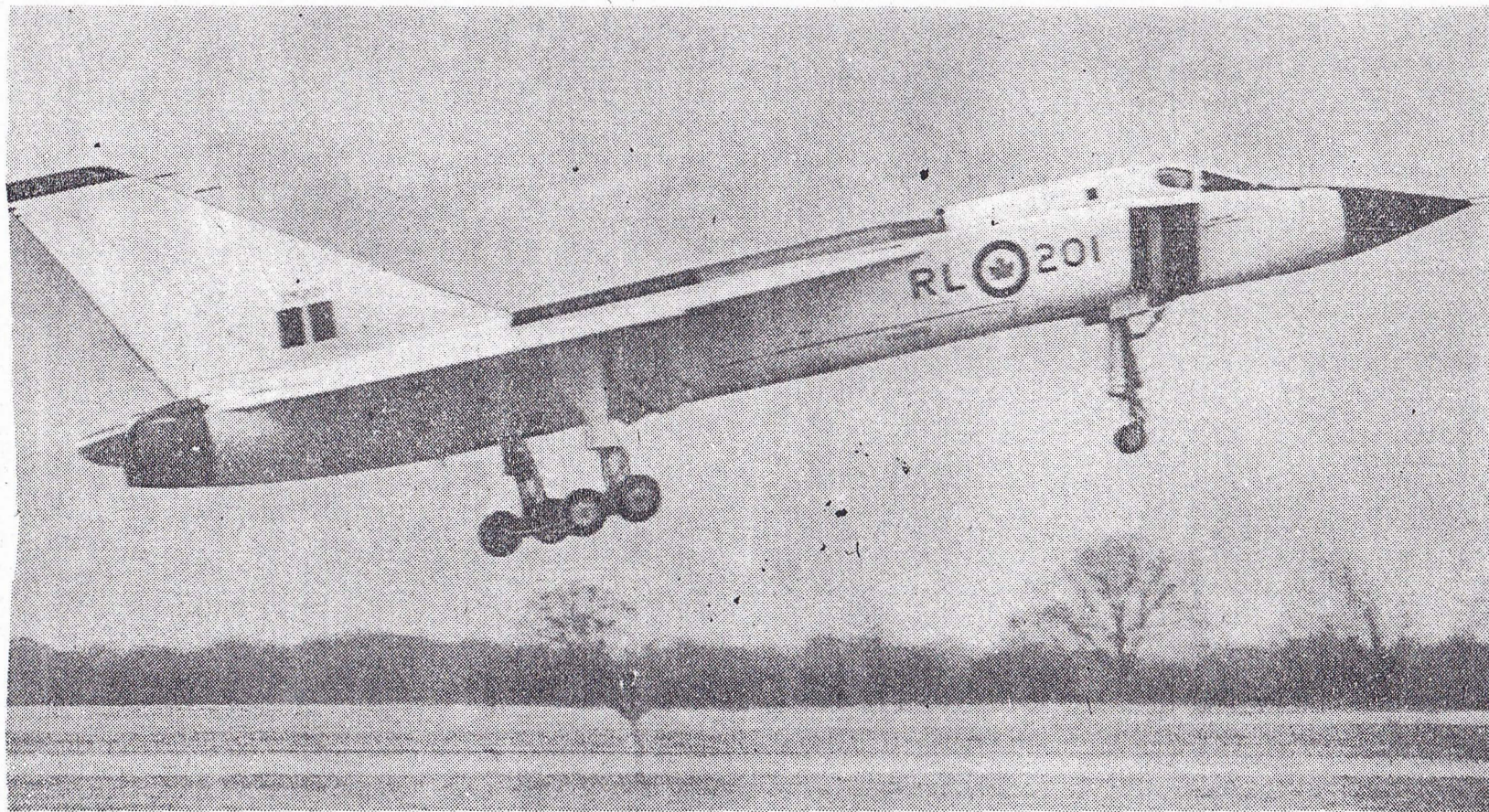


Avro Arrow Comes Through Maiden Flight With 'Flying Colors'

THE DELTA-WINGED AVRO ARROW darted into the air at Malton airport today for the first time.
