1. During our recent discussions of the AVRO VTOL project we promised to give you our recommendation of certain additional tasks that might profitably be undertaken to advance the concept. A listing of the tasks which the U.S. Air Force recommends at this time is attached for your consideration. Estimated costs are indicated wherever possible.

2. Included among the recommended tasks are several that were presented as a part of the USAF planned program for the coming fiscal year. Subject to the availability of funds, the U.S. Air Force plans to undertake those tasks which were previously discussed as well as the newcomers on the attached list.

USAF plans to undertake all listed tasks.

3. The USAF reaffirms its invitation to the Canadian Government to participate with the USAF in this program which we believe fulfills a common objective.
