## Avro Jetliner Thrills Americans

New York, April 20 (CP). — A flight demonstration by the Canadian-built Avro Jetliner thrilled 350 members of the Society of Automotive Engineers at New York international airport today.

The demonstration by the four-engined Jetliner featured the final session of the society's four-day convention here.

The plane circled the field at low level several times, made a 60-degree bank at 300 feet, levelled off and gave a speed display at 330 miles an hour. Then it went into a 75-degree climb at 6,000 feet a minute.

Avro's chief test pilot, Donald Rogers, who was at the controls, gave a running description over the public-address system as the plane went through its manoeuvres.

Hitting a 350-mile-an-hour clip, Rogers swept across the field, rocking the plane's wings from side to side to show the manoeuvrability and control of the plane. On the return run, he went through the same routine at a much slower speed.

Tuesday the Jetliner flew from Toronto to New York on a goodwill flight in 59 minutes 56 seconds. It will make the return flight tomorrow afternoon by way of Montreal.
