Dear Ted:

I have arranged an appointment for you with Sir Roy on the morning of September 4th. Sir Roy will be prepared to spend most of that day with you.

He recommends that you take about two days, Tuesday and Wednesday, September 5th and 6th, at the Air Show, meeting the people who come into the Hawker Siddeley Reception Centre. He feels in this way you will meet practically all the more important people in the aircraft industry, not only in England but in a good many other countries.

Owing to the number of people who have applied for seats at the Dinner, he is not certain at this time that he will be able to arrange a seat for you, but he will try.

Between now and the time you arrive in England Sir Roy will work on an itinerary for you that will take in most of the plants and make it possible for you to meet the Senior Executives. I told him that you would be leaving on the 12th or 13th to return to Canada.

I will send a message over to Miss Bailey (Sir Roy's Secretary) advising her the number of your flight and the time of your arrival in London. Hawker Siddeley will then have a car meet you at the airport.
