



A unique view of the Avro Canada CF-100 Mk 4 from The Imperial War Museum at Duxford, England. It was Canada's main all-weather fighter of the 1950s, and the first combat aircraft of all-Canadian origin. The aircraft has a 53.5-foot wingspan and is 54 feet long with a service ceiling of 45,000 feet, and a top speed of 640 mph. This aircraft was built in 1955, and spent a large part of its operational life at Zweibrücken, Germany...a base I know well!
