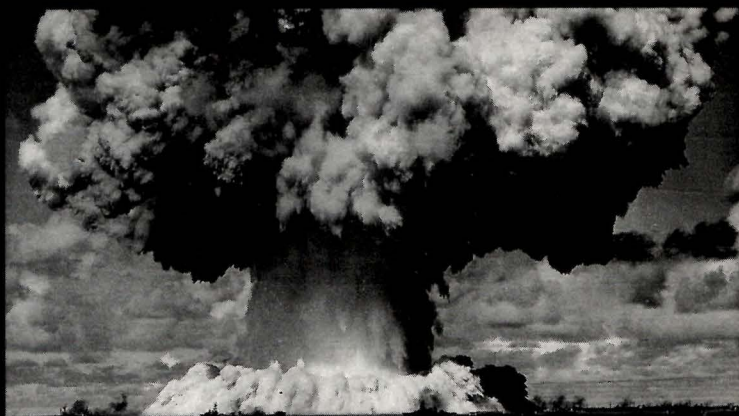


BUNKERS BUNKERS EVERYWHERE

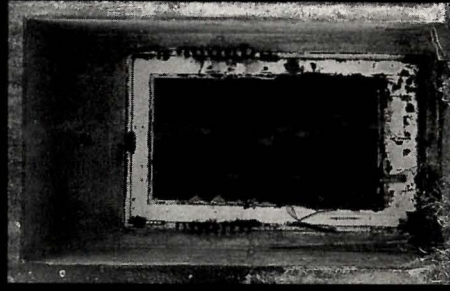
