No doubt you are aware of the urgency associated with the AVROCAR program, and how important it is both to the Group and to the Company to have the first test vehicle flying in the shortest possible time, particularly if we are to retain the lead we now have in the development of VTOL aircraft.

The Management have scheduled the roll-out of the first AVROCAR for early March 1959.

Having therefore set the objective it has been decided to start working overtime from 5.30 p.m. to 9.30 p.m. beginning Thursday May 1st and every Tuesday and Thursday thereafter for the next six to eight weeks.

We know we can rely upon you to do your part by assisting in every way you can to accelerate the release of engineering information, drawings and lofts to the Manufacturing Division, so that they can get ahead with the construction of the test vehicle.

We realize this is a tremendous challenge, not only to those of us in Special Projects but to our Production people as well. Let us then join forces and working as a team we shall succeed.
