124	8	The Canadian government made the decision to purchase 138 F-18 Hornets, manufactured by the American firm McDonnell-Douglas, a variant of Northrop's F-18. (See photo page 179)
130	21	"contact" should read "contract"
135	10	Five years after the writing of the book, on August 31, 1983, another Korean Airlines aircraft, this time a "Jumbo" Boeing 747, flew into Russian airspace and was in fact intercepted by a Russian fighter and deliberately shot down. All 269 people aboard were killed.
155	7-8	Israel Aircraft Industries Ltd. is now called Israel Aviation Industries.
155	16	The cost of the updated "Lavi" fighter is projected at \$34.5 million per aircraft. Israel is continuing to develop the fighter and as of June 30, 1986, as reported in <i>Forbes</i> magazine, had a prototype virtually ready to fly.
