CF-105 RUNWAY REQUIREMENTS

In view of the uncertainty of the D.O.T. carrying out the proposed extensions to Halton runways prior to the flight of the CF-105 first prototype, the R.C.A.F. are attempting to have funds raised by D.D.P. to allow this work to go ahead.

Since, however, it is by no means certain that these modifications will be made for May, 1957, I asked Jim Chamberlin to look at the runway requirements for the CF-105. I am enclosing a copy of his brief statement for your perusal.

I believe that Bob Lindley, Jim Chamberlin, Yourself, and myself should get together on this as soon as you have had a chance to consider it.
