CF-105 RCAF EVALUATION

In a meeting between A/C Truscott, G/C Footitt, G/C Aldwinkle, W/C Brough, W/C Hamilton, and the writer at AFHQ on Wednesday, May 30/56, the following data was promised to the R.C.A.F. as soon as possible.

The Company will provide the R.C.A.F. with a short write-up showing what they can expect in terms of handling qualities on a time basis, i.e., as the damping system is working out.

This is to indicate to them as simply as possible what the evaluation test pilot can expect to achieve at any given time. This data could probably take the form of a flight envelope where the handling qualities are considered to be reasonable, based on Phase A by October '57, Phase B by January '58, Phase C by April '58, and Phase D by July '58.

The R.C.A.F. have agreed to confine any evaluation at this stage to a C.E. & P.E. pilot and to keep the operators out of it, and the assessment pilot will be brought into the program prior to flying the aircraft to get a good assessment of what he can hope to evaluate.
