Glen McLarty was picked as Canada's best amateur pilot and winner of the Webster Memorial Trophy, September 25, at the Trophy finals, held this year at Ancienne Lorette Airport with the Quebec City Flying Club as host to the contestants.

Mr. McLarty, who is 21, received his flying training at Central Airways Company on Toronto's Island Airport. The fact that he is a graduate of a commercial school makes him somewhat unique among Webster Trophy winners, since for some time a virtual monopoly on the annual award has been held by graduates of RCFC member clubs.

This year's winner started flying last January and has accumulated a total of 160 hours flying time. He is planning to take his commercial license shortly.

Runner-up in the competition was Dr. William Young of the Kingston Flying Club.

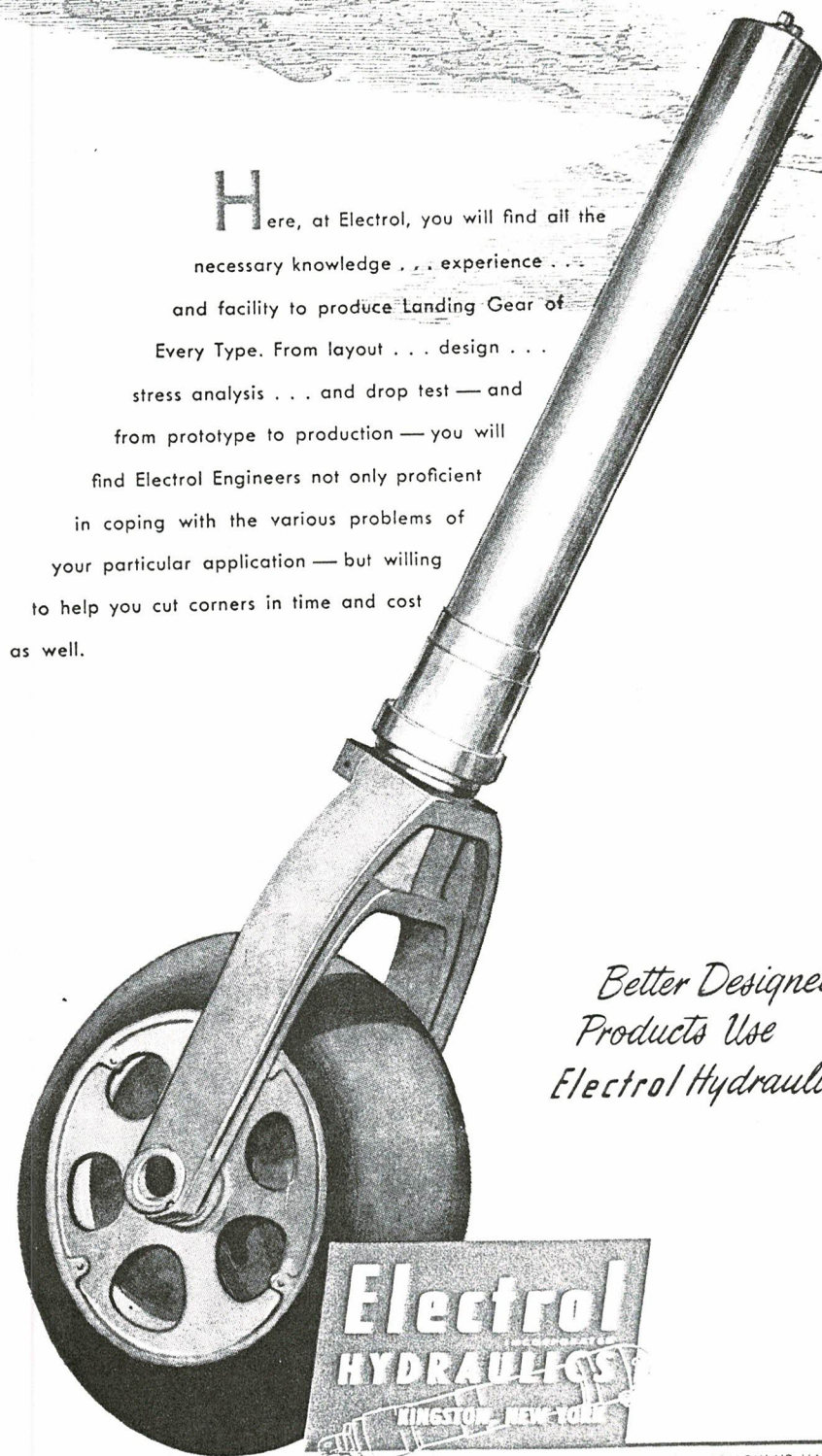
