Rebuilding Aircraft for Peacetime Flying

The RCAF Training and Patrol Aircraft Become Useful Load Carriers For Bush and Charter Work When Conversion Work is Properly Done


IRCRAFT Industries of Canada Limited might be termed a good example of successful reconversion. In making former RCAF service aircraft available for various peacetime uses in Canada, South America and the Dutch East Indies the 70-odd employees, all of whom have had aviation experience dating back to before the war, have opened up a promising future for themselves.

When the magazine paid a visit to the self-contained workshop of the company at St. Johns Airport, an hour's drive from Montreal, 41 aircraft were being worked on and others were coming in. The company expects to keep using its long conversion experience for overhaul work and for the change-over of various types of planes, say freighters to passenger types. The company also has a charter from the Department of Transport to carry passengers on nonscheduled trips.

Since last June work has been carried on in two of the former Air Observers' School's double hangars. Stores, workshops and overhaul facilities are thus under one roof. The airport has excellent 2,600-ft. runways, taxi and parking strips. Previous to June the workshop was at Cartierville Airport in the hangar now used by the Montreal Flying Club.










