Some aircraft operating today are severely limited in the amount of payload and/or fuel that can be carried from hot and high airfields. The low-cost Avro 748 can operate from these 'critical' airstrips without restriction on useful load. Where restrictions must be applied, these are much less severe than for any other aircraft in this class. The Avro 748 takes off and lands safely on semi-prepared surfaces, and can operate with full payload from airfields of very limited runway length. At maximum take-off weight of 33,000 lbs. (14,970 kgs.), the total distance to take off and reach a height of 35 ft. (10.69 m.) is 2,520 ft. (768 m.) in International Standard Atmosphere conditions at sea level. This aircraft can also take off in 3,500 ft. on one engine.
