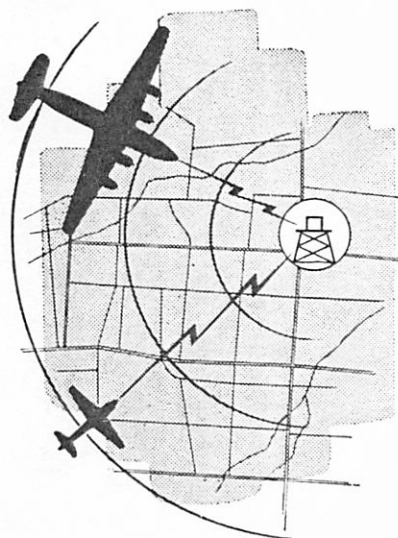


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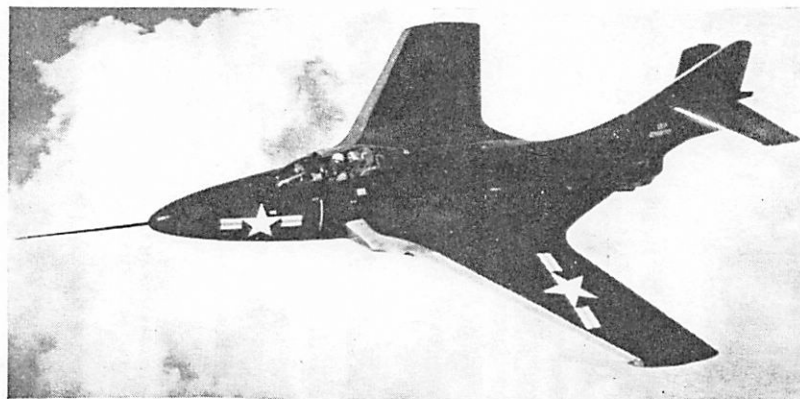
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COUGAR: The Grumman F9F-6 Cougar is the latest of a long line of "Cat" type USN fighters to be produced by Grumman Aircraft and is the swept wing successor to the Grumman Panther. The Cougar is already in full production, but details of its performance are still classified, except that it is rated at "over 600 mph", same as the Panther, though Grumman says that it is much faster than its predecessor.
