A still spry CF-100 twin-jet fighter and the skill of two members of No. 414 (Electronic Warfare) Squadron were combined in February to establish a non-stop distance-speed record. Navigator, Captain Gregory Bruneau (left), and pilot, Major Norman Hull, flew their CF-100 over 2,300 statute miles from Comox to Ottawa in four hours, 16 minutes and 15 seconds on 16 February. Their average air speed was 407 knots at 37,000 feet, with a 70-80 knot jet stream adding some push.
