

JANUSZ 'ZURA' ZURAKOWSKI

Janusz is one of the world's most famous pilots. He is a Polish Canadian who has been at the forefront of cutting edge aviation technology. Raised in Poland, he joined the Polish Air Force in 1934 and during the war escaped to England in 1940. After a brilliant wartime career he test flew aircraft in England and in Canada, to where he

immigrated in 1952. The most notable aircraft tested by Zura was the Canadian supersonic interceptor known as the CF-105 Avro Arrow.

Some of Janusz's distinctions are:

- · Polish Cross Virtuti Militari
- Cross of Valor with two bars
- Gold Pin of Polish Club of Test Pilots
- McKee Trophy '58
- · Canadian Aviation Hall of Fame inductee
- · Canadian Flight Test Centre in Cold Lake, Alberta (main building bears his name)
- · Honourary Fellow of International Society of Experimental Test Pilots (Jan is the first Canadian or Polish pilot to receive this honour - this Society includes Lindbergh – first flight across Atlantic, Sikorski - creator of the helicopter and Armstrong – first man on the moon)



MADAWASKA VALLEY

The Madawaska Valley area is

located in the southwest corner of Renfrew County and treasures three communities.

The village of Barry's Bay was settled in the last half of the 19th century by Polish and Irish settlers. The neighbouring hamlet of Wilno was the first Polish settlement in Canada (1859). Combermere, the hamlet 20 km to the south, is the home of Madonna House, headquarters of a world-wide Catholic lay charity organization.

LOCATION OF ZURAKOWSKI PARK

Zurakowski Park is being constructed on the arrow-shaped property across from the Barry's Bay Railway Station. The park will consist of a large scale replica of the Avro Arrow aircraft with a statue of Janusz Zurakowski, as well as a tourist pavillion with interactive displays.

Opening ceremonies are scheduled for Saturday, July 26 at Zurakowski Park. A gala evening of dinner and dancing will feature the SPITFIRE BAND. See the website for updated details.






