#### CITY CHAMPIONSHIP SERIES

Starting on Thursday, July 2nd, Gulfport's Championship team will compete against similiar teams from 18 other Leagues for the Greater St. Petersburg city championship.

The Senior Division city championship series will start on Monday, July 13th.

#### WORLD SERIES TOURNAMENT

An "All-Star" team of 14 of our 11 and 12 year old boys will represent Gulfport in this series, starting on Eucaday, July 21.
Winners will advance through District, State, and Regional Tournaments to the Little League World Series in Williamsport, Pa. in August.



#### PITCHING

Pitching is the most strenuous position in baseball. Little League Regulations insure that no boy does enough pitching to endanger his health, and they work to prevent any team from depending upon too few pitchers.

Not more then two - 12 year olds may pitch in a week.

No boy may pitch in more then six innings during a week.

A boy who pitches in less then four innings in a game must have one days rest before again pitching.

A boy who pitches in four or more innings must have three days rest before again pitching.

If a boy is removed from the mound, he may not pitch again in that game. He may continue the game in any other position.

A team may not use more then five pitchers in a game.

The announced starting pitcher must complete pitching to the first batter of the other team.

Minor League Regulations are the same except that 12 year olds may not pitch.

No boy, or his parents, are ever charged any fee for him to take part in Little League. Nor is admission ever charged at any Little League game.

### ABOUT SAFETY

It is no accident that Little League Baseball has the finest safety record of any organized sport in the world. It is the result of years of study and research into safe playing practices and improved safety equipment. One of the League's Directors is designated as the Safety Officer. His duties are to be continually on the watch for safety rule violations, and for unsafe equipment, and to remove these conditions before they cause accidents.

Little League has many safety rules - there are three in which parents can be of real help in enforcement:

Catchers must wear supporters with protective cups.

Players must not wear rings, watches, pins, or any other shiny objects during games.

Boys who must wear glasses should have the non-shattering safety glass type.

For the safety and comfort of our spectators, no running, fooling, horseplay, or playing of games will be permitted in the stands, around the refreshment counters, in the parking areas, or in the toilets.

## ABOUT THE

## MINOR LEAGUE

The Minor League is primarily a training program. It is here that most boys get their introduction to real baseball, with teams, rules, umpires. It is here that they, hopefully, learn the principles of fair play, team work, and self reliance.

The Little League field will be devoted to the Minors all day every Saturday. Each of the teams will play a full six inn - ing game each week for nine weeks. The rules will be modified for training, and to insure a more interesting game.

There will be no "walks" or base on balls. Each batter will either hit the ball, or strike out.

Stealing to home on wild pitches will not be permitted.

The Managers may call time as often as they wish to go out on the field for instruction sessions.

Umpires will remove a pitcher who throws too many wild pitches, or otherwise delays the game.

Managers will try to play every boy some in every game. Besides the Saturday games, each team will hold evening practice sessions frequently.
