





The First Town Hall - 1913

The first Gulfport "Town" Hall was built in the "early Orange Belt depot" architectural, style in 1913 for a cost of \$1,259.75 Constructed by C. C. Sawyer, it stood in Chase Park approximately where the shuffleboard courts are now located. It was funded by proceeds from the first municipal bond issue and was painted yellow


The Gulfport Historical Society is a non-profit association dedicated to the operation of the Gulfport Historical Museum, where data and artifacts concerning the history of Gulfport are collected, preserved, and exhibited The Museum, located at 5301 28th Avenue South also serves as a resource for research material for both

individual citizens and historians. The Society publishes a newsletter, a yearly civic calendar, and provides a monthly series of informative programs for its members and guests. In addition, two programs of wide community interest are held yearly, the Annual Birthday Bash celebrating the anniversary of Gulfport's incorporation in October, and a Nostalgia Day Open House in March

People with an interest in the history of their town or a desire to learn more about it are always welcome to join in any of these activities. The Society and the Museum depend entirely on volunteers to served on committees, research and care for the collections, act as docents, or do any of the many tasks necessary to maintain our facilities

1999 was a busy and successful year, with the completion of the photo archiving project and the publication of the book, "IMAGES OF AMERICA: GULFPORT." Available through the Museum or at any local bookstore, this handsome paperback is a nostalgic look through the last hundred years of our history with some 215 pictures of the town, its houses and businesses, its parks and people

In 2000 we anticipate more achievements, such as the completion of a major construction project to bring our entrance ramp and rest rooms up to ADA standards, and the final cataloging of the collection.



Gulfport Elementary School's first home was described by a contemporary as an "artistic stone building, with four large airy light rooms, extensive playgrounds and gardens." Not mentioned were the two small outhouses about 200 feet from the building. The school housed 80 pupils.






