LITTLE LEAGUE FIELDS

TOMLINSON PARK

Tomlinson Park has been renovated during the year 2002. It is scheduled for grand opening in January 2003. The renovated park will have two Little League Fields, a walking trail, a new skateboard park, a tot lot playground, a boardwalk and an ecologically improved stormwater pond. The previous pond was increased by 38%.

Lake Tomlinson is about a one acre man-made pond located in Gulfport at the Northeast corner of Tangerine Avenue and 55th Street South. Approximately 115 acres drain to the pond. The outflow from the pond flows south through a 42 inch diameter pipe and discharges into another man-made pond in Pasadena Yacht and Country Club Golf Course.

The purpose of the project is to provide additional storage to reduce flooding and improve the water quality treatment to the runoff by enlarging the pond, removing some impervious area, reconstructing three pipes discharging into the pond, constructing littoral zones along the banks, constructing an outfall structure, and constructing a boardwalk to an educational area with an educational sign. The educational sign will explain the importance of cleaning urban runoff prior to reaching Boca Ciega Bay.

In addition, the roadway on 55th Street has been improved, along with improved drainage throughout the area. There will also be decorative antique lights and benches surrounding the park.

The City will plant 18 Bald Cypress trees approximately 12 to 14 foot in height. Bald Cypress is a beautiful tree. Its foliage is particularly attractive in early Spring as its leaves out and again in the Fall as it turns first golden, then brown, then reddish. It produces good shade in the Summer for those walking, picnicking, or relaxing on a park bench.

The Bald Cypress will help provide a sound barrier for neighboring residents. This is of particular importance for reducing the noise from the active uses in the park (ball field, court games, playground).

The Park renovation has been partially funded by the Southwest Florida Water Management District, Florida Department of Environmental Protection, U. S. Department of Interior, Land and Water Conservation fund, Urban and Community Forestry, Penny for Pinellas and the City of Gulfport.

The Gulfport Historical Society is incorporated under the laws of the State of Florida as a not for profit association, dedicated to the operation of the Gulfport Historical Museum, where data and artifacts concerning the history of Gulfport are collected, preserved, and exhibited. The Gulfport Historical Museum is located at 5301 28th Avenue South and serves as a resource of research material for both individual citizens and historians. Our hours of operation are 2:00 pm - 4:00 pm Monday through Friday and 10:00 am - 12 noon on Saturday. The Society

publishes a quarterly newsletter, a yearly civic calendar, and provides a monthly series of informative programs for its members and guests. In addition, two programs of wide community interest are held annually; the *Nostalgic Birthday Bash* celebrating the anniversary of Gulfport's Incorporation on October 12, 1910, and introducing in 2003 a special night replacing the springtime Nostalgia Day. Our first offering will be a *Silent Film Festival* to be held at the Catherine A. Hickman Theater of Gulfport on Friday night, February 21, 2003.

The Society and Museum depend entirely on volunteers who serve in every capacity from being a member of a committee, to conducting research and caring for the collection, serving as docents, or fulfilling any of the many tasks necessary to maintain our facilities and continue to raise the funds needed for its operation.

In 2002, we were fortunate to be given access to the genealogies connecting the families of McRoberts, White, Webb, Hudson, Thompson, and Trudell, and linking them back to Rebecca Slaughter Barnett. Many new names were added to this genealogy at the Birthday Bash of 2002. Through the efforts of our Historian, Lynne Brown, we now have genealogy records for many of the founding families. Some of these families are Nash, Renney, Roberts, Manns, Wilson, Pollard, and Wintersgill, to name but a few. Lynne has compiled over 3000 names of descendants of these and other families. We appreciate any, and all, assistance anyone can give to this endeavor.
