

The Gulfport Historical Society was incorporated under the laws of the State of Florida as a not-for-profit association in 1981, with its major function dedicated to the operation of the Gulfport Historical Museum, where data and artifacts concerning the history of Gulfport could be collected, preserved, and exhibited for the community. The Gulfport Historical Museum is locatied at 5301 28th Avenue South and serves as a resource of research material for both individual citizens and historians. Our hours of operation are from 2 p.m. – 4 p.m. Monday through Friday and 10 a.m. – Noon on Saturday.

The Society currently has three volumes of published Gulfport History and publishes a quarterly newsletter, and provides informative programs for its members and quests. We have over 3000 names in the Gulfport genealogy listing of the first families. In addition, the Nostalgic Birthday Bash will mark its Centennial celebrating the anniversary of Gulfport Incorporation on October 12, 1910. Enjoy a Gulfport tradition of fish fry, mullet toss and a trolley tour of Gulfport! Also, another large event, the Gulfport Centennial Celebration on Saturday, October 16 will involve all local business in the Community to Celebrate the Centennial Taste of Gulfport. Along with the celebration, a huge two day Art Show filled with local Artist will cover the Gulfport Casino Ballroom. All will be Gulfport for the weekends of October 9 and 16. 2010!




