The Gulfport Historical Society is thrilled to bring you our 2015 wall calendar. We've rebooted the calendar to give it a fresh look, and hope that by doing so we've encouraged you to take a fresh look at the history of our quaint seaside town. We started our journey in 1981 and dedicated ourselves to the gathering, distribution and preservation of Gulfport's history. We open our doors to people throughout the week, and a museum board member or volunteer is always ready to meet with you by appointment if you wish.
