



## Capital Improvements

The City of Gulfport is embarking on some of the most extensive Capital Improvement Projects to be undertaken in recent years. The most exciting aspect of the proposed projects is the funding. The City has successfully formed partnerships with various agencies of the State of Florida, other municipal governments, as well as local civic groups, to finance these projects. As a result, NO property tax monies will be needed to fund these major improvements. Some of the more significant capital projects include:

LIBRARY EXPANSION — As depicted in the artist rendering above, the expansion will double the size of the Library and will include a meeting room, enlarged childrens area, doubling of the reference desk, and much more. The Friends of The Library are especially commended for their contributions in raising funds for this project.

MUNICIPAL COMPLEX - The new municipal complex will combine the functions of City Hall and the Police Department into one efficient and cost effective building. The project also includes the renovation of the City work yard and offices within the Public Services building. Upon completion of the new building, the current City Hall, the transfer station building and both buildings housing the Police Department, will be razed to provide landscaped parking areas.

OSGOOD POINT — As one of the few remaining, undeveloped pieces of land on Boca Ciega Bay, the project will involve improvements in the shoreline and creation of a passive park with boardwalks. The desire is to promote the revitalization of the natural wildlife and plant life for all to enjoy for years to come.

REDEVELOPMENT — The City of Gulfport will be using grant funds to improve the intersections of 28th Avenue and Beach Blvd., and Dupont Street and Shore Blvd. Storm water drainage improvements and additional parking are included in these projects. A residential and commercial property improvement program is also being designed for implementation this year.
