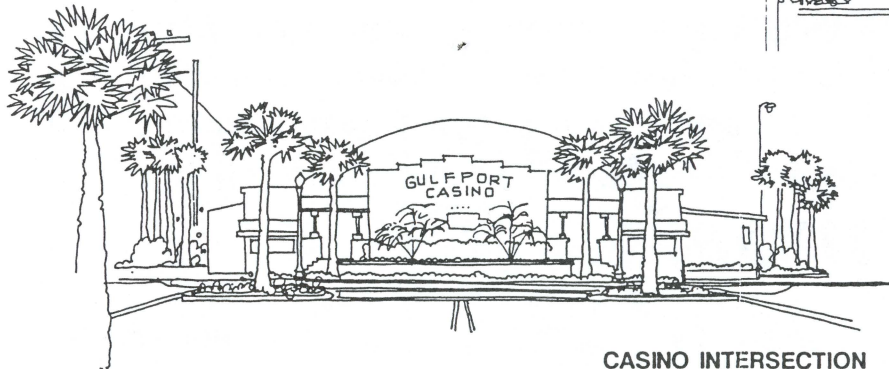
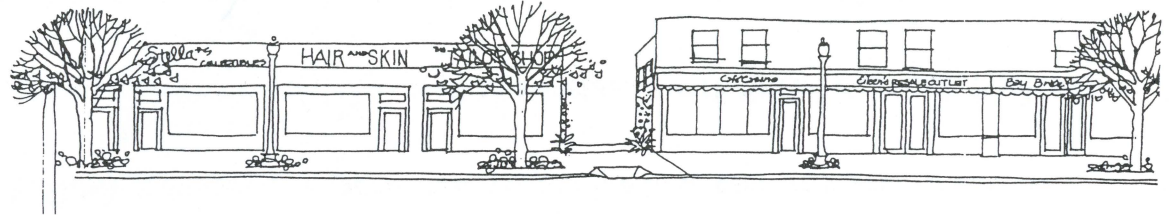
Special Services

- ★ City Hall is the location for paying Water/Sewer, Florida Power, General Telephone, and Time Warner Cable bills.
- ★ Check out Audio and Video tapes, as well as books, at the Library and attend children's story time.
- ★ Reassurance Program providing daily contact for residents living alone.
- ★ Gulfport Extended Mini-Bus Service (G.E.M.S.) provides transportation from home to doctor or store for elderly and/or handicapped.
- ★ Senior Center provides Congregate Dining and food commodities as well as assistance with Social Services, Social Security and Income Taxes.
- ★ Tot Time day care three days a week; Pre-School program of three or five days a week; and daily after-school recreation programs are provided at the Community Center.
- ★ Full summer recreation program for children ages 5 through 13.
- ★ Ships' Store at Marina and boat ramp.
- ★ Building Permits, Occupational Licenses, Inspections and Beach Parking stickers can be obtained at the Public Services Building.
- ★ Curb side Recycling; clear glass, plastic, aluminum, newspapers.

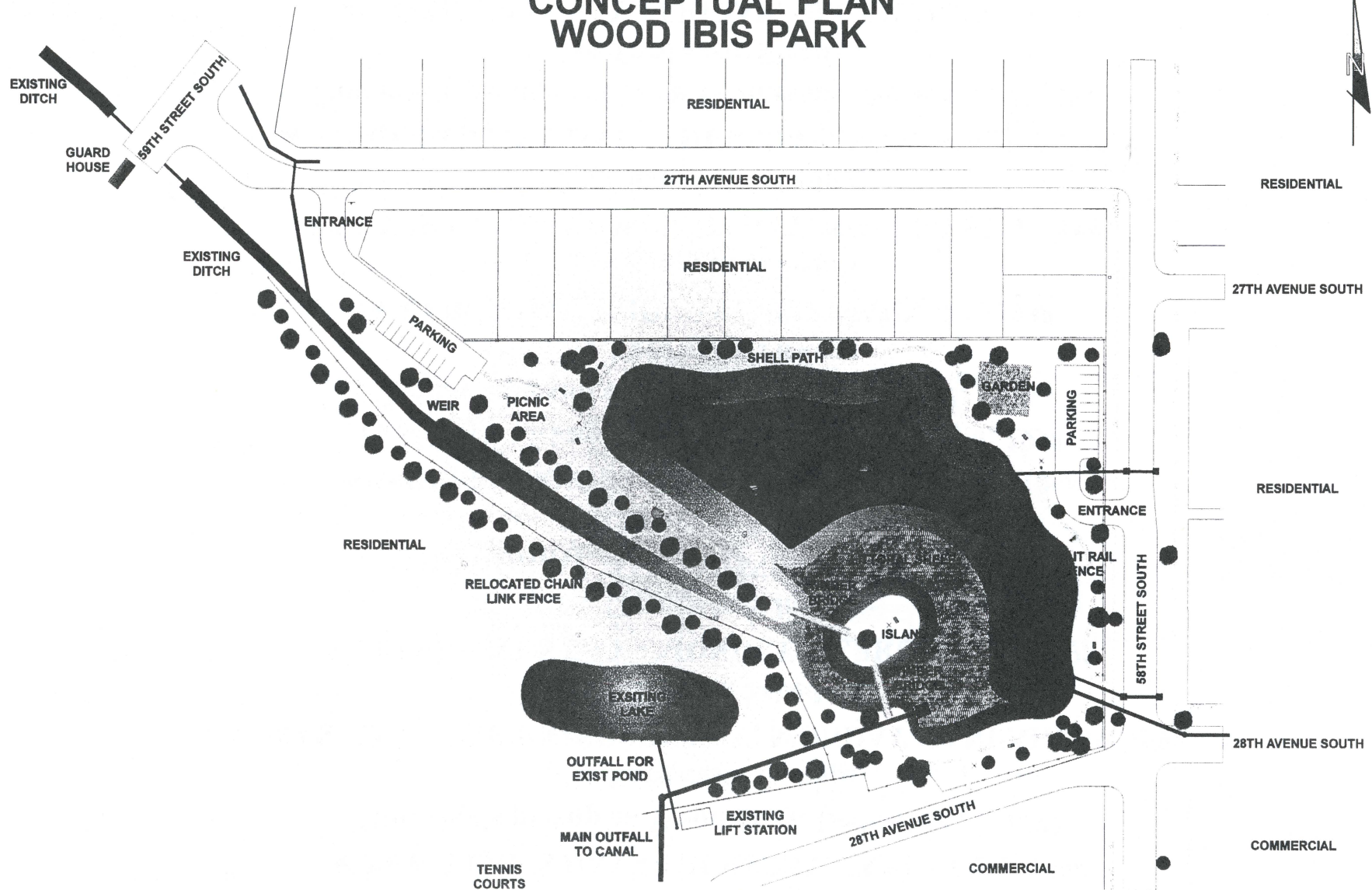

The following drawing is Architect Emmett Walsh's rendition of our expansion dream.

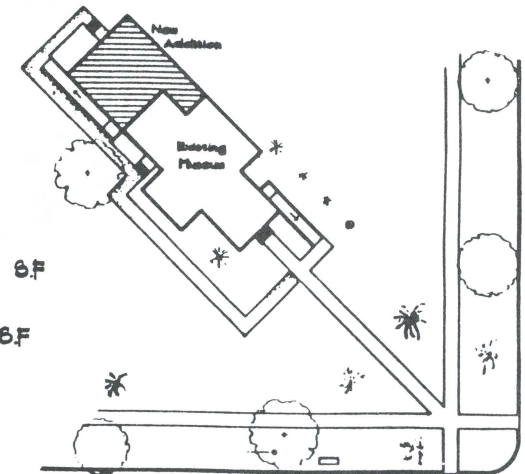
